

## AUDITION REQUIREMENTS DANCE/MOVEMENT

- **Please visit the link located on our audition webpage to sign up by August 15th, 2025**
- **Arrive promptly or before your scheduled audition**  
Check-in with the receptionist prior to your scheduled time
- **Submit the following information to the receptionist:**
  - Completed Parent/Student Information and Nomination Form
  - **Two (2) Community Nomination Forms** on behalf of your child. These should come from **individuals with specific knowledge of your child's artistic abilities** (e.g., a private music instructor, dance coach, art mentor, etc.). **Do not ask your child's current classroom teachers** for a recommendation, as they have already provided input as part of the evaluation process..
  - Critique of previous performances, recitals, talent contests, arts shows, solos, etc. (Submit only if the child had received a formal or informal critique. Please do not create a critique. Lack of critiques will not count against the child. Limit critiques to two).
  - Letter written by the student that describes how and why he/she became interested in the art form, why he/she continues this art form, and what he/she hopes to accomplish in this art area. (Letter must be no more than one page in length).

### SPECIAL NOTES:

- **All auditions will be personal and only in the company of the judges. No friends or parents/guardians may observe the audition.**
- **This will be the only scheduled audition this year. Make-up sessions cannot be arranged.**
- **In order for your child to audition, all components must be submitted upon arrival.**

### DANCE AUDITION:

Each student must wear dance attire or shorts and a fitted top, not loose or baggy. Dance shoes or tennis shoes must be worn.

Prior preparation for the audition process is not necessary.



Students auditioning for dance/movement will be taught group combinations on site and be asked to perform the combinations in a small group setting.
