### **Course Spreadsheet**

The [Fall 2024 ES Course Spreadsheet](#) lists all of the courses that count for the ES major that are being offered in the fall. There are some courses that count but don't have Env Studies numbers, so they can be hard to identify on TitanWeb.

### **Skills Course Options:**

Students can register now for the summer field course, EGRT 374. This is a great course where you spend a week at a beautiful Northwoods environmental education campus and a week in the lab here on campus. Other skills courses include English 388: Grant Writing Foundations (only offered every two years) and Geog 241: Intro to GIS.

### **Courses Offered and Not Offered:**

#### **ES 260: Environmental Science only offered in the Spring**

This core ES course, which is typically offered every semester, will only be offered in Spring 2025. If you are just getting started on the ES major, ES 101, 102, and 282 are good options!

#### **ES 282: Environmental Humanities might only be offered in the fall**

We don't yet know the Spring 2025 schedule, but it is possible that ES 282: Environmental Humanities will only be offered in Fall 2024. This is a required course for all ES majors and minors. If in doubt of whether you would need it in the 2024-25 school year, please plan to take this course in the fall.

**ES 490 offered ONLY IN THE FALL**

We will only be offering ES 490: Senior Seminar in the fall. That means anyone planning on graduating in Fall 2024 or Spring 2025 needs to take the course in Fall 2024.

**ES/PS 357: Environmental Policy will not be offered; substitutes available**

ES/PS 357 will not be offered. If you need this course to graduate, we have several options. You can take Poli Sci 316 Policy Design & Analysis. If you have taken ES/Geog 306: Environmental Conservation, this course could be used instead of 357, and then you would need an additional upper level ES elective in its place. ES/Geog 306 will be offered in Spring 2025. Talk to your advisor about other options if these two don't work for you.

**ES/Geog 306: Environmental Conservation--only offered in Spring 2025**

Geog 306 is required for Env Science emphasis students and is one of the few classes that can be an elective in either Env Science or Policy and Values. It will be taught in Spring 2025. If you need the course to graduate in Fall 2024, work with your advisor on a substitute course.

**Students who need help from UARC**
