- 3. Pray three Hail Marys (one each for an increase in faith, hope, and love/charity)
- 4. Pray the Glory Be To The Father.
- 5. Announce the 1st Mystery and while meditating pray: Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be...., and O My Jesus....
- 6. Announce the 2nd Mystery and while meditating pray: Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be...., and O My Jesus....
- 7. Announce the 3rd Mystery and while meditating pray: Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be...., and O My Jesus....
- 8. Announce the 4th Mystery and while meditating pray: Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be...., and O My Jesus....
- 9. Announce the 5th Mystery and while meditating pray: Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be...., and O My Jesus....
- 10. Conclusion may include the following prayers: Hail Holy Queen; Let us Pray; Prayer to St. Michael; Memorare; Sign of the Cross

THE ROSARY

THE APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. AMEN

OUR FATHER

[Leader] Our Father, who art in Heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth it is in heaven. [RESPONSE] Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. AMEN

HAIL MARY

[Leader] Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. [RESPONSE] Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. AMEN

GLORY BE (The Doxology)

[Leader] Glory be to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit [RESPONSE] as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. AMEN

OH MY JESUS (THE FATIMA PRAYER)

O, My Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell, and lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy.

HAIL HOLY QUEEN (The Salve Regina)

Hail, holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn, then, most

gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us; and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

[Leader]: Pray for us, O holy, Mother of God.

[Response]: That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.
