

Ohtani's 25th home run! Bang!! 53

Home Run Face Shaking

LA Angels' Shohei Ohtani exploded his 25th home run. At this rate, the immortal myth that the home run king will also win 10 games as a pitcher is possible.

Otani started as the second designated hitter in the 2023 Major League Baseball game against the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field in Colorado on the 24th. He recorded an OPS (on-base percentage + slugging percentage) of 1.014 with three hits, one home run and one RBI in five at-bats. Otani is the only player in the Major League who has exceeded OPS 1.

The game was won by Colorado 7-4.

Home runs are also the No. 1 in the Major League. In the American League, Aaron Judge (New York Yankees), second place, hit 19. The difference is quite wide. Ohtani can make 53 home runs arithmetically if he maintains his current pace.

Otani also appeared in 15 games as a pitcher, recording 6 wins, 3 losses and a 3.13 ERA. Since more than half of the season is left, it is expected to achieve 10 wins easily. The unprecedented title of 10-win pitcher home run king is expected.

Ohtani exploded a double from his first at-bat in the top of the first inning. It was not linked to the score due to a failed follow-up hit. In the top of the third inning, when he faced 2-2, he stepped down with a fly ball to center field.

Otani broke the balance in the top of the fifth inning. He came out as the leadoff hitter. Colorado starter Kyle Freeland hit a changeup. He technically hit the ball close to his body. He went over the fence on the right. The Angels led 4-2, with the next batter Mike Trout exploding a back-to-back home run.

Ohtani completed the three-hit game by hitting a hit in the sixth inning with two outs and no runners.

However, Otani's performance did not lead to victory.

Colorado recovered one run in the bottom of the sixth inning. Ezekiel Toba's timely hit chased 3-4.

Colorado presented Coorsfield's fear to the Angels in the bottom of the eighth inning. Leadoff hitter Harold Castro opened the door with a right-handed hit. After Jurickson Profa stepped down on a fly ball to center field, Toba hit a hit to build up a runner.

The Angels faced a disaster as Ryan McMahon got on base due to an error. Elias Diaz hit a come-from-behind grand slam with one out and a full base. [토토사이트 추천](#)
