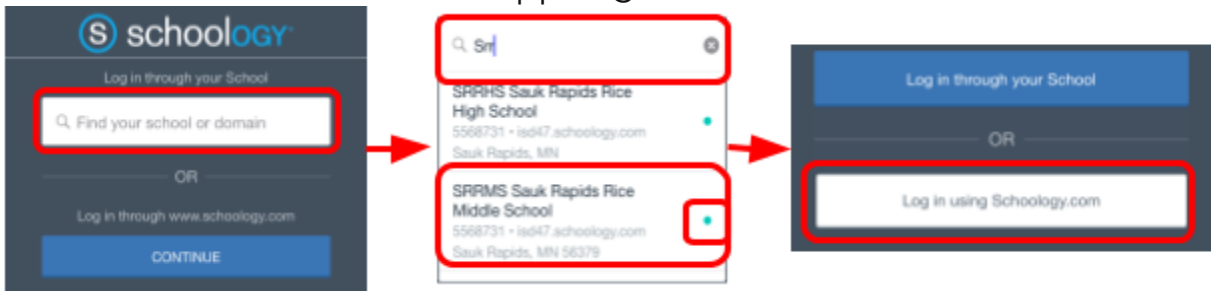

Your Parent Schoolology Account Compared to Your Child's

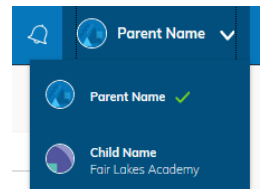
Having a Parent account in Schoolology is actually like having two accounts:

1. Your personal account, with your own name and information;
2. Your Child Activity view. From here, you can view Schoolology from your child's perspective, and see what he or she sees, and receive updates about his or her activity.
 - a. Start by clicking on the arrow in the upper-right corner, next to your name, and then select your child's name to switch into his or her account.

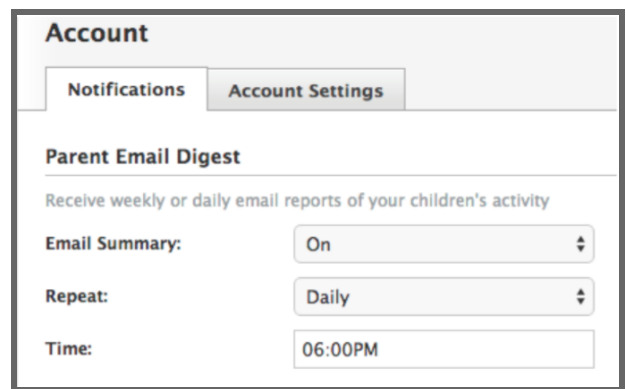
Notifications

Set up your Notifications to control how Schoology contacts you about your child's school activities.

To set up notifications, select Settings from the dropdown menu in the upper right hand corner then select Notifications.

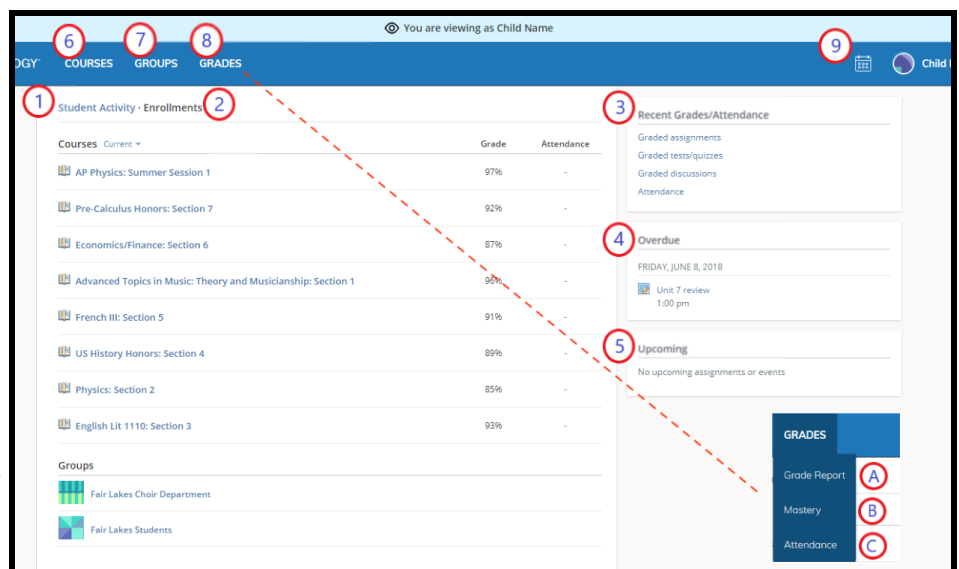
Parents can also choose to receive a notification every time a due date passes without an assignment submission.

Student Activity

The Student Activity area displays the most recent updates, submissions, comments, and grades for a student account. To filter these items, click the **Most Recent** toggle to the right of the Student Activity heading.

Click on the arrow in the upper-right corner of your account and select your child's name to view his or her activity. From the home page, you can quickly view specific information about your child's Schoology activity:

1. The Student Activity area in the center of the page displays your child's recent submission, grade, and attendance information.
2. Toggle into Enrollments in the same area to see a list of the courses your child is currently enrolled in, along with his or her grade. You can also view courses as your student views them.
3. The Recent Grades area lists graded assignments, tests/quizzes, and discussions. To view the graded items, click the item you'd like to view.
4. The Overdue section displays a list of course materials your child did not turn in by the due date and that have not been marked "missing."
5. The Upcoming section displays a list of your child's upcoming assignments and events.
6. Courses: You can see a list of your child's current courses.
7. Groups: You can see a list of your child's Schoology Groups.
8. Grades: Depending on the settings in place at your child's school, this menu provides access to view the following:
 1. Grade Report: Review your child's grades for all courses.
 2. Mastery: If your child's school aligns materials to standard and learning objectives, you can check your child's progress in this area.
 3. Attendance: Review your child's attendance for all courses.
9. Calendar: Click to view a calendar of past and upcoming events and assignments.
