INTERalliance partners with many local businesses and school districts to offer a variety of Internship opportunities in IT for students in High School.

Internship Eligibility Requirements

You must be completing 9th-12th grade this year. You must be able to provide your own reliable transportation to and from your internship.

(If you already have an agreement with a company, this may be waived. Please contact us to discuss in more detail.)

You will need a one-page resume to submit with your application. (Please contact resume@interalliance.org for resume questions or assistance.)

Things to Consider BEFORE You Apply

Internships are guaranteed a minimum gross wage (before taxes are withheld) of \$13 an hour.

Each Internship could have a slightly different schedule. In general, you can expect to work full time (37-40 hours per week) for 9-10 weeks from the first week in June to the second week in August.

Companies will typically allow a one-week vacation during this time. However, there is no guarantee that your request will be approved. Each request is handled on a case-by-case basis. The vacation request must be submitted to the company and INTERalliance.
