• Driving

 staircase. Please help with traffic flow by having your student exit or enter
 the car at any time your vehicle is stopped between the lines of the
 designated Drop Off / Pick Up Area.
 - Student drop off / pick up in the upper parking lot, closest to the school, is not a designated Drop Off / Pick Up Area and is only for those individuals who have a physical necessity.

• Student Parking

- Unfortunately we have reached our student parking capacity, there are no more available student parking spaces. At this time Student Parking is closed for any new drivers.
- Non-registered drivers are not permitted to park on school grounds and any violators are subject to towing at the cost of the vehicle owner.
