MIAMISBURG HIGH SCHOOL 2024 SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION: Summer School is an opportunity for students to make up or recover credit for classes they have failed. Credits may be earned in any of the four academic areas: Math, Language Arts, Social Studies and Science. The academic courses will be offered through the online credit recovery program Grad Alliance. MHS teachers will work with the students and monitor their progress, but the students will be responsible to learn the content and complete the work through the online program. Credit will be awarded as soon as the student completes the course. Any course taken during the summer will become part of the student's permanent record. The Miamisburg High School code of conduct applies also to summer school.

ATTENDANCE: Students must attend during their scheduled time. Absences for vacations or trips will NOT be permitted during summer school. If students miss more than one class or have more than 2 tardies, FOR ANY REASON, they may be removed from the class. NO REFUND will be made to students removed from class because of attendance, tardies, or discipline.

TRANSPORTATION: Students must provide their own transportation and may park in the parking lot in front of the building.

COURSES:

Science: A course for students who have failed a Science class during the school year. Upon completion, students receive 1 Science credit.

Math: A course for students who have failed a Math class during high school. Upon completion, students receive 1 Math credit.

Language Arts: A course for students who have failed English 9, 10, 11 or 12 during the school year. Upon completion, students receive 1 English credit.

Social Studies: A course for students who have failed a Social Studies class during the school year. Upon completion, students will receive 1 Social Studies credit.

Government: A course for students who have failed their one-semester Government course. Upon completion, students receive ½ Government Credit

Physical Education: PE is <u>not</u> offered during summer school.

SUMMER SCHOOL TUITION & PAYMENT: The cost of each academic course is \$100. The tuition for Miamisburg students who qualify for a fee waiver is \$50. **Payment is to be made by check, money order, or credit card before or on the first day of summer school.** No refunds will be made if a student fails to attend or complete the course.

SUMMER SCHOOL SESSION 1:

Date: June 3 - June 21 / Time: 8:00 am - 12:00 pm

Students may continue working on their coursework online at home if extra time is needed to complete a course or courses.

SUMMER SCHOOL SESSION 2: Remote Learning (At Home Only)

Date: June 24 - July 12

Session 2 is reserved for students enrolled in session 1 and need to complete another course. If a student does not register for a course in session 1 or registers and does not meet attendance requirements during session 1, the student cannot attend session 2. Students will do all their work at home using the same online option as in session 1. We will have a summer school coordinator who will be available to check student progress and answer technology related questions.
