

## 2023 ANNAPOLIS TO GALESVILLE RACE

### NOTICE OF RACE/SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### **0 A CLEAN REGATTA**

- 0.1** This event is a registered Clean Regatta with Sailors for the Seas, aiming for Bronze or Silver Certification. Please read the regatta webpage for what this entails for both WRSC and our competitors.

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1** The Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, together with the rules of the participating classes.

#### **2 ENTRY**

- 2.1** All sailboats are welcome to participate. The Race Authority has the right to deny entry if it is deemed incompatible with the race set up.
- 2.2** Entry is free to members of WRSC, \$10 for non-members to be collected after the race.
- 2.3** Boats can pick up tow from WRSC to Annapolis the morning of the event.

#### **4 THE COURSE**

- 4.1** The course shall be as it is depicted in Appendix A2G. Distance: 11.01nm



## 5 THE START

5.1 The start will be between the G"9" and the RC Flag on the Hallie Q.

5.2 Warning Signal will be at 12:55:00

5.3 Starting sequence will be pursuit style. All boats starting times are equated from their US Sailing Portsmouth System/ DPN numbers to PHRF with start times calculated Time-on-Distance.

OCS Penalty: If a boat is OCS, they will be charged a 45-minute penalty without a hearing.

## **6 The Finish**

- 6.1** The finish will be in Tenthouse Creek in Galesville, between the WRSC burgee flying on the pier and an Orange Drop Mark.

## **7 SUPPORT BOATS**

- 7.1** Support boats shall be marked with the letters WRSC or as described at the competitor's meeting.

## **8 PENALTIES**

- 8.1** Penalties should follow Rule 44 of RRS. Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed for all classes, so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required as per Appendix V.1

## **9 CHECK IN**

- 9.1** Before starting the race, all competitors shall sail astern the Committee Boat – or contact the Race Committee (RC) on VHF Channel 5, give their sail number and be acknowledged by the RC. Any competitor who leaves the race before the completion of racing shall notify the RC before leaving the race.

## **10 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

- 10.1** Channel Five (5) is WRSC's standard channel for all operations and this event.

## **11 PRIZES**

- 11.** Bragging rights.
