National K9 Dock League Rules

National K9 Dock League is a Dock Diving League partnering with International Dog Sports. The goal of National K9 Dock League is to bring you and your club a Friendly Competitive Dock League and build a local community.

Clubs- You need at least 8 Teams to form a club, A team is 1 dog and 1 Handler, You are allowed to have a holder on the dock. Each club needs at least 1 day a month to record their jumps for League Nights. Each club is competing as a whole team to face off against every other club across the country and facing off head to head!! YOU DO NOT NEED TO OWN A FACILITY TO BECOME A CLUB CAPTAIN, however you just need to find a place to do the jumps (with permission and the facility owners knowing what you are doing).

Seasons- National K9 Dock League will go by "Seasons". This season is going to be from May 1st- Aug 31, Club captains will subm in it their league nights for the season, and NK9DL will make a game Schedule for who each club will face this season in your head to head matches

MAY- NEED 1 LEAGUE NIGHT

JUNE- NEED 1 LEAGUE NIGHT

JULY- NEED 1 or 2 LEAGUE NIGHT

AUGUST- NEED 1 or 2 LEAGUE NIGHTS

CLUBS MUST OFFER 5 LEAGUE NIGHTS. N

TEAMS MUST BE PRESENT FOR 3 OF THE 5 LEAGUE NIGHTS FOR SCORES TO COUNT.

Dock Requirements-

Dock must be a minimum of 40 feet x 8 feet.

Pool must be a minimum 40 feet x 18' feet.

Yes ponds are allowed with correct and accurate ways to judge and pictures of it approved. National K9 Dock league will allow any facility to participate as long as the facility owner is made fully aware of your plans and says it's ok.

SCORING SYSTEM

Scoring- The way Scoring will work is each team gets two rounds. A round consists of 3 jumps. So after you do Both rounds, the farthest 5 jumps of your 6 jumps will count towards the League Night scores. Every member's score for the club will be added together and then the total club score will be averaged. The higher Club average is the winner for that league night. If a dog catches the toy they get an extra point each catch.

Divisions-We will be following IDS divisions
