Head	As God's child, I should glorify Him in all that I do.

Large Group Time		
Praise & Worship	15 Minutes	<p>1.</p> <p>2.</p> <p>3</p>
Missions Moment	5 minutes	<p>Remind the kids that we love praying for nations, because we want everybody, everywhere to know Jesus like we do. During our "Masked Singer" theme, we're going to be praying for Christians who have to hide their identity because people are not allowed to be Christians in their country - those who are discovered are often put in jail or hurt.</p> <p>Have a leader come in wearing a mask painted with the flag of North Korea.</p> <p>Today we are going to pray for our Christian brothers and sisters in North Korea.</p> <p>Have the children lay hands on the leader and have 3 or 4 children pray out loud.</p> 
Intro (Video & Discussion)	5 minutes	<p>For this series, our intro video will be of a masked member of our congregation, who will be singing "Who you say I am" by Hillsong. At the end of the video, the kids will have 20 seconds to shout out their guesses of who they think the masked singer is. Have fun with this.</p> <p>Explain that many people spend their whole lives trying to figure out who they are, and why they are even alive. As Christians, we don't have to have this struggle. We can know who God made us to be. The first thing that we need to know is that we belong to Jesus. <b>As God's child, I should glorify him in all that I do!</b></p>
Bible Teaching	15 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Read John 1:12 &amp; Romans 8:8-16</b> (If possible, have the kids bring out their Bibles, and look these passages up to read with you.) These passages talk about how we are God's children.</li> <li>• Bring out a whiteboard, and have the kids tell you what rights and responsibilities they have, because they are their parents' children. Chat about which apply to us as God's children - add any extra things you can think of... Here are some ideas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I am protected</li> <li>- I have authority - I can speak to sickness and tell it to go.</li> <li>- I can call God my Daddy, and talk to him as a Dad.</li> <li>- All that God has is mine.</li> <li>- God will discipline me to teach me to be the best son or daughter I can be.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Isn't it awesome that we can be God's children. But as God's children, we also have some responsibilities.</b> Read 1 Corinthians 6:19 &amp; 20. Discuss it. Explain that to glorify the Lord means to make him famous. If time allows, play <a href="#">this video</a>.</li> </ul>

## Small Group Time

Discussion	5 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What do you love about being God's child?</li> <li>• How do you think you can make Jesus famous in the way you live your life.?</li> <li>• Think of someone you know who glorifies Jesus by the way they live their life. Chat about what makes them stand out.</li> <li>• Pray for one another.</li> </ul>
Craft	10 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hand each child a coloured cardboard photo frame and craft page.</li> <li>• Have them draw a self portrait and place it into the frame as a reminder to live a life that makes Jesus famous.</li> <li>• You can also have the kids decorate the frame with stickers if time allows.</li> </ul> 
Memory Verse	While waiting for parents	<p><i>Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous - how well I know it. Psalms 139:14</i></p> <p>This is the memory verse for this theme. Hand each child a memory verse card, and read through the verse together a few times.</p>
