### How Much it Costs to Ship a Car To and From Nevada?

On average, you will have to pay around \$1 per mile to ship a car within Nevada state or to the nearest states. However, the prices go down as the distance increases to \$0.75 per mile for under 500 miles and \$0.4 per mile for longer distances (over 600 miles).

For instance, it will cost you around \$1 per mile, if you ship to nearby cities like:

- Salt Lake City, Utah = 380 miles = \$380
- Phoenix, Arizona = 500 miles = \$500
- Los Angeles, California = 480 miles = \$480

But, if you ship your car over 600 miles, the prices will change, such as:

- From Nevada to Seattle Washington = \$0.75 per mile 900 miles = \$675
- From Nevada to Chicago, Illinois = \$0.6 per mile for 1780 miles = \$1068
- From Nevada to New York City, New York = \$0.4 per mile for 2550 miles = \$1020

- **Type of Vehicle:** Your car's size, weight, and model also impact the final shipping price. For instance, shipping a Honda Civic will be cheaper than shipping a Tesla Model Y.
- **Method of Transport:** You have two options for transport methods when shipping your vehicle, and which one you choose directly affects the final cost. For instance, the most popular of them is open carrier transport and it's the most budget-friendly option as well. Open carrier transport costs 30-50% less compared to enclosed or other transport methods. While an enclosed carrier is comparatively safer for your vehicle, it'll typically cost more.
- **Seasonal Fluctuations:** Summer is the [peak moving season](#) nationwide, so naturally it's the busiest time for moving companies with more bookings and less vehicle capacity which makes the prices go high. While comparatively, if you ship your car in winters that'll be much cheaper.

## How Long It Takes for Car Shipping To and From Nevada,

We understand how crucial the on-time delivery of your valuable vehicle is. And that's why we take about only 2-4 days to deliver your car within 200 to 500 miles of distance. However, it is important to note that the time it will take to move your car to longer distances (around 600 to 2000 miles) will be more – about 4-9 days.

Here are a few examples of how long it will take to move your car from Nevada to the nearby states (under 500 miles):

- From Las Vegas, Nevada to Los Angeles, California, it may take around 2-3 days (about 270 miles)
- From Reno, Nevada to San Francisco, California, it will take around 2-3 days (around 220 miles)
- From Henderson, Nevada to Phoenix, Arizona, we will ship in approximately 2-4 days (around 300 miles)

But, if you want us to ship your car over 600 miles away, it might take longer. For example:

- From Las Vegas, Nevada to Seattle, Washington, we will ship in around 5-7 days (about 1,100 miles distance)
- From Reno, Nevada to Austin, Texas, it may take around 6-9 days (roughly 1,700 miles)
- From Henderson, Nevada to Chicago, Illinois, we will ship in approximately 6-9 days (around 1,750 miles)

Despite a given estimated time, if you experience a delay in your car's delivery, these common factors might be the reason:

- **Weather situation:** Weather conditions impact the delivery timeline, such as [Nevada winters](#) are usually harsh with strong winds and lots of snow, which leads to dangerous travel conditions and a definite delay in the delivery of your vehicle. It is advisable to stay in touch with your shipping company, so they can inform you about any expected reschedules or changes to the route.
- **Traffic and road conditions:** According to this [news report](#) citing different studies and an [Urban Mobility Report](#), the average annual delay per auto commuter in the U.S. was 54 hours in 2022 due to traffic congestion in recent years. So these two (traffic congestion and other road conditions) can also be the reason behind a shipment delay.
- **Mechanical issues:** A slight delay may occur if your shipment truck experiences any kind of mechanical issues. Though it's not a frequent thing, we're to address every possibility honestly.
- **Pickup and delivery locations:** A delay can occur in case we're shipping to a remote or hard-to-reach area. But don't worry, you will be informed about the possible delay. However, it's highly recommended to be available during the pickup and delivery process of your vehicle, as it directly impacts your vehicle's shipping timeline.

## Car Registration Process in Nevada:

When you move your out-of-state registered car to Nevada, the [Nevada DMV office](#) requires you to change its [registration within 30 days](#) of becoming a resident. Or if you're already a resident and you've purchased a car either from outside Nevada or within the state, you're still required to register your vehicle at a Nevada DMV office.

Here are the steps for each process:

### If You're New to Nevada - Car Registration Process in Nevada:

- 1. Gather Required Documents:** Before you visit the DMV office, you're required to gather the following documents:
  - Your current vehicle registration and license plates
  - Proof of Ownership, or if you're leasing, a lease agreement
  - Proof of residency
  - Your Nevada Evidence of Insurance Card from a company licensed to sell insurance in Nevada.
  - A Vehicle Inspection Certificate ([Form VP15](#)), if your vehicle is from out of state
  - A Nevada Emission Vehicle Inspection Report, if your vehicle is subject to emission rules
- 2. Visit the DMV Office:** Visit your local DMV office (get an appointment to reduce the waiting time) and fill out your Application for Vehicle Registration ([Form VP222](#)). You can fill this form out online as well.
- 3. Pay Registration Fees:** Pay the registration fee based on your car's size, weight, and other factors.
- 4. Receive Your New Registration Certificate and License Plates:** Finally, get your new registration certificate and license plates in a few days or a couple of weeks.

**Note:** Don't forget to check on the DMV website what inspections apply to your vehicle.

### If You're a Resident of Nevada - Registering a Vehicle in Nevada:

You need to register your newly purchased vehicle in Nevada within 30 days of your purchase or before its temporary permit expires (whichever comes first). However, the process of registration varies depending on your vehicle's source. Here, we've enlisted the steps to register your vehicle in Nevada when you've purchased it from a Nevada dealer:

- 1. Visit Your Local Nevada DMV Office:** Within 30 days of your new purchase, visit your local NV DMV office
- 2. Submit Documents:** Gather and submit the following documents in the DMV office:
  - Your driver's license or your ID card
  - A green copy of the Dealer Report of Sale (very important)
  - Your proof-of-insurance card (very important)
  - A Nevada Emission Vehicle Inspection Report
  - Application for Vehicle Registration (Form VP222). Make sure to date and sign it.
- 3. Pay the Registration Fees:** Pay your registration fees according to your car's value

You're eligible for [online registration](#), if your Nevada dealer has participated in an [EDRS program](#). This is better if you're looking to avoid the waiting time, as you can register your vehicle from your home.
