

2024 AGHS Weekly Go Problems

Rules and Regulations

Mission Statement:

The Weekly Go Problems was created as an opportunity for players to practice problems on a weekly basis to foster consistent Go studying.

Information:

There will be a set of **five** problems on a google form sent every Sunday to our participants who will have the week to complete **one** problem to submit.

Participants may submit solutions for all problems they complete, but only **one** solution will be graded. Points will be awarded based on problem difficulty, and difficulty and point value will range as follows:

- Level 1: 15k-10k - 10 points
- Level 2: 10k-5k - 15 points
- Level 3: 5k-1k - 20 points
- Level 4: 1d-3d - 25 points
- Level 5: 3d-5d - 30 points

Partial credit is awarded if the first move of the sequence is correct and will be 5 points regardless of problem level submitted. A leaderboard will be updated weekly based on participant submissions. There will be a separate general and youth leaderboard; participants under **18 years old** will qualify for the youth leaderboard and should indicate on the weekly google forms. Prizes of simuls and game reviews will be awarded to top participants.
