Recorded Police Calls for September 2021 was **120**. Total number of actual crimes in Holm/Lochardil area was **17** with **15** crimes already detected with person/s charged.

Ward and Local Policing Plan Priorities.	Activities conducted over the reporting period to support those priorities.
1. Anti Social Behaviour	Community Officers continue to identify, engage and disrupt anti-social behaviour of persons in and around Holm / Lochardil. Weekend evening patrols on cycles continues to be beneficial in deterring anti-social behaviour in young people with groups in the area. There have been two reports of threats. One has been detected and reported and enquires are ongoing into the other. There has been one report of an offensive weapon. This has been detected and reported. There has been one report of assault and 2 reports of police assault. All have been detected and reported. There has been one report of vandalism. Enquires are ongoing.
2. Drugs/Alcohol Misuse	It is important that the Community work with us to combat drug misuse in the Community and we welcome continued information on hotspots, individuals and addresses where this is occurring. There have been two reports relating to drugs. They have both been detected and reported.
3. Public Protection	There has been 1 report of a domestic crime. This has been detected and reported.
4. Crimes of Dishonesty	It is important that we guard against online fraud particularly around our more vulnerable residents as there is an increase in reports by the wider Inverness community. There has been 1 report of Fraud which has been reported and resolved. There have been two reports of theft. One has been reported and enquires are ongoing into the other. There has been one report of extortion. This has been detected and reported.
5. Road Safety	There has been one report of drink driving. This has been detected and reported. There has been one FP issued. There has been one report of an RTC. This has been detected and reported.
