What We Provide

Mentoring & Support: Our experienced team provides personalized mentorship to youth across the Philippines who are passionate about conservation. Through one-on-one guidance, we help young leaders develop their project ideas, refine their skills, and overcome challenges along the way.

Project Leadership: Youth participants lead their own conservation projects within their communities, driving positive change from the ground up. We offer capacity-building for crowdfunding, grant writing, project management, and environmental stewardship to equip youth with the skills they need to succeed. Through hands-on learning experiences and one-on-one mentorship, participants gain practical knowledge and build confidence in their abilities to make a difference.

Fiscal Sponsorship: As their fiscal sponsor, we facilitate funding opportunities for the projects of Youth leaders. Grantors typically prefer supporting established organizations due to accountability and oversight needs, ensuring funds are used effectively. By channeling funding through CS, grantors can be confident in the responsible and transparent management of their resources. CS takes on fiduciary responsibility, supporting & training youth project leaders to manage finances, handle reporting, and ensure legal compliance on behalf of youth-led projects. By providing oversight on managing finances, handling administrative tasks, and ensuring accountability, we empower Youth leaders to work on what they do best: Creating meaningful impact in their communities.

How It Works

1. Apply to join the CS Youth Leader Incubator Program

2. Participate in a 12-month training program

Accepted participants will engage in a structured 12-month training program covering various modules:

Module 1: Understanding Leadership

Module 2: Identifying Environmental Problems and Designing Project Solutions

Module 3: Grant Writing Fundamentals

Module 4: Crowdfunding Strategies

Module 5: Grant Writing Execution - Participants will identify and apply for three grants.

Module 6: Crowdfunding Execution - Participants will conduct their own crowdfunding campaign, with the option to utilize CS platforms for support.

3. Receive Mentorship Throughout the Project Cycle

Upon successfully raising funds, CS will provide ongoing mentorship and support throughout the project cycle, from inception to completion. This mentorship includes guidance on project implementation, budget management, reporting, and overcoming challenges encountered along the way.

By participating in the CS Youth Leader Incubator Program, aspiring environmental leaders will gain the skills, knowledge, and resources needed to initiate and execute impactful conservation projects within their communities.
