5. Admire the Stunning Architecture

The core of Buena Park is the [Hutchinson Street Historic District](#). This two-block stretch near Montrose Park dates back to 1894 when the architect [George W. Maher](#) designed and built mansions with gorgeous [prairie-style architecture](#) here.

Today, the Buena Park Neighborhood Association organizes walking tours to admire these stunning houses from the outside.

Getting Around Buena Park and Chicago

If you're commuting to downtown Chicago, you have plenty of transportation options in Buena Park. The [CTA Red Line](#) connects the neighborhood to the city. Alternatively, you can also take [bus 135 Express](#) to get downtown fast, or [bus 36](#) to reach closer destinations. And if you're driving, there's no scenic route to the city like Lake Shore Drive.
