Countryside Inn Clean & Simple Card Instructions

Cutting Instructions

- Thick Basic White CS: 8-½" x 5-½" scored at 4-¼" so that your fold is on the left side of your card base.
- Basic White CS: 5-¾" x 4-⅛"
- Balmy Blue CS: 5-½" x 2-¼"
- Countryside Inn DSP: 4" x 2-¾"

Assembly Instructions

1. Using the Countryside Corner die that measures 3-½" x 2", die cut the upper right corner of the regular Basic White CS leaving about ⅝" of an inch on the top and right side.
2. Glue the DSP behind the opening you just made and then glue this piece to

- the front of the Thick Basic White card base.
3. Die cut the curved leaves from the Dainty Delight die set out of the Balmy Blue CS and then glue it to the left side of the die cut opening on the front of your card.
4. Stamp your greeting with the Night of Navy stamp pad onto the Basic White CS that you cut out with the Countryside Corners die.
5. Die cut your greeting using the smallest stitched rectangle from the Timeless Arrangement dies and attach it with dimensionals below the opening on the front of your card. I arranged it so that it looks like the stems are coming from behind the greeting.
6. Put three blue pearls on the DSP.
7. Stamp your sentiment using the Night of Navy stamp pad on the right inside panel of your card.
8. Stamp the flowers and stems using the Balmy Blues stamp pad on the lower left corner on the right inside panel of your card. You can also stamp the same thing on the lower left corner on the front of your envelope.
9. Using the Balmy Blue Watercolor pencil, color the flowers and leaves and then blend them in using the Blender Pen.
10. Using the dottage stamp from the Color & Contour Stamp Set and the

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Balmy Blue stamp pad, stamp off and then stamp over the top of your flowers about three times. Do the same on your envelope.



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
