Title:	Facilitating Referendum for UVSS Co-op Fee Exemption
Mover:	Torin
Seconder:	Zach S.
Goal:	Students not pay UVSS fees on co-op
Whereas:	ECS students pay disproportionately more fees to the UVSS. Students on co-op are often unable to access the services they pay for. ECS students taking four co-op terms will pay roughly \$150 more than regular students to the UVSS over the course of their degree
BIRT:	The ECSS organizes a petition for a UVSS referendum to exempt students on co-op from UVSS fees. This includes reaching out to other groups such as the Commerce Students' Society and those who represent other students in mandatory co-op programs. This further includes informing ECSS membership about the petition/referendum process, collecting signatures, and ultimately submitting the petition to the UVSS if it receives the requisite signatures. The ECSS should make every effort to collect the signatures in time for the next UVSS elections. The ECSS

	council should appoint a proponent from the student body. If nobody wants to be a proponent, it shall be postponed to the following semester.

	<p>Within 31 days of being presented to council if there are no school breaks that are over or equal to 4 consecutive days.</p> <p>Within 75 days of being presented to council if there is a school break between 5 and 10 days in length.</p> <p>Within 61 days of being presented to council if there is a school break between 11 and 20 days in length.</p> <p>Within 90 days if there is a school break over 21 days in length.</p>
BIRT:	For the purpose of this motion, the days between terms in which there are no classes are also be considered breaks, other than the half terms in the summer.
