Supply List for Harpists

in place of the orchestra supply list

These are the supplies that will travel with you from home to school each day:

- 1-inch or larger 3-ring binder (black only)
- Binder dividers with labels--will be labeled on our binder-building day
- Pencil bag (3-holed for binder—this is important for organization and keeping pencils/tuning keys easily accessible. If you didn't have one last year, please get one for this year!)
- Pencils with erasers
- 1 highlighter
- Nail clippers-this is both for cutting strings and trimming your nails if needed so you can make a good sound in class!
- Loose-leaf lined paper (for binder) **OR** notebook (some place to write notes/practice journal). You don't need both loose-leaf paper and a notebook, just one or the other.
- Ergonomic rubber-covered tuning key (can be found at harp.com or vanderbiltmusic.com--here
 is a link to an example of what you're looking for:
 https://www.harp.com/?s=ergonomic+tuning+key)
 - Please note there are also wooden and metal tuning keys. These are strongly not recommended for home use and not allowed for school use—if they accidentally fall as happens often, they will damage the harp.
- Tuner (preferably one with a pickup that will clip on to the harp)
 - A cell phone tuning app is fine! There are lots of free ones!
- Optional: plastic page protectors
- Harp Olympics method book (None for Beginner, Blue for Intermediate, Green for Advanced, Red for High School),
 - 6th grade: Your first method book is provided by the harp program. By winter break, you will need to purchase Harp Olympics Stage I by Susann McDonald and Linda Wood Rollo. (yellow cover)
 - 7th grade: Harp Olympics Stage II by Susann McDonald and Linda Wood Rollo (blue cover)
 - 8th grade: Harp Olympics Stage III by Susann McDonald and Linda Wood Rollo (green cover)
 - High School: Harp Olympics Stage IV by Susann McDonald and Linda Wood Rollo (red cover)

These are the supplies you need at home:

- Home harp!
- Adjustable bench or stool to sit on--should be steady and not have wheels. Most non-adjustable piano benches are too low but may work if you add a cushion.
- Music stand
