

McGraw-Hill Setup

1. Add McGraw-Hill to Your Course

- Navigate to your course where you want to integrate McGraw-Hill content.
- On the left-hand menu, click on **"Settings"**.
- In the "Settings" menu, select **"Apps"** (or **"External Tools"** depending on your institution's setup).
- Search for **"McGraw-Hill"** (you might see "McGraw-Hill Connect" or "McGraw-Hill Education").
- Once found, click **"Add"** to integrate McGraw-Hill into your course.

2. Configure McGraw-Hill in Canvas

- After adding McGraw-Hill, you will likely be asked to link your McGraw-Hill account to Canvas. If you don't have an account yet, you may need to create one through the McGraw-Hill website.
- **Log into McGraw-Hill:** Use your McGraw-Hill credentials to authenticate the connection.
- Choose the relevant McGraw-Hill product (like Connect, SmartBook, etc.) that you want to use in your course.

3. Add McGraw-Hill Content to Your Course

- After linking your account, go back to your course's home page.
- Use the **Modules** or **Assignments** section to add McGraw-Hill content.
 - For example, you can add **Connect Assignments** or a **SmartBook** link.
- To add content, click the "+" button in your desired module and choose **"External Tool"**.
- Select **McGraw-Hill Connect** or the specific McGraw-Hill tool you'd like to use.
- Once selected, you can configure the specific McGraw-Hill content, such as assignments, tests, or readings, and include it in your course materials.

4. Sync Grades from McGraw-Hill to Canvas

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- McGraw-Hill assignments will be synced automatically with your Canvas gradebook.
- Check that the **grade sync** feature is enabled.
 - This is often done by default, but you may need to ensure it is set to sync grades at specific intervals (e.g., after each student submits or when assignments are graded).

5. Publish Your Content

- After adding McGraw-Hill content, ensure everything is published and available for students.
- You can preview the content to make sure it's set up correctly before students access it.
