

## POKEMON XENOVERSE POC by Serpent19

Hello all, and welcome to my Pokemon Xenoverse guide! This game is pretty new, and I'm sure I will probably miss something in this guide, so feel free to let me know. Pokemon Xenoverse has 389 Pokemon for you to collect and 38 X Pokemon for a total of 427 Pokemon. This game has the B/W scaled experience system, so expect this to take a while. Luckily you will have access to Pickup, so you can try to get your hands on some Rare Candies. Since this game uses Gen 5 assets, I am going to assume that the Pickup chart is the one from B2/W2 until I have further conformation. Now onto the guide!

### **Section 1(Basil):**

#### **39 Pokemon/3 X Pokemon**

After proceeding through the intro as normal, you will get to choose a starter. In this game your starter doesn't evolve so be prepared to not use it. You need to choose Shulong; otherwise you will fail the challenge. You will find out why in Section 4.

### **Shulong**

After even more intro stuff, you will eventually meet of with your Nana. She will give you some Poke Balls, and force you into a battle with a Weedle.

### **Weedle (7) Kakuna (10) Beedrill**

Don't worry if you fail to catch it, this is not the only one. After you battle your mom, you can catch more Pokemon. Here you can get:

Get a Pickup squad going, as you will really need them. Get them all to Level 21. (Not now obviously) Soon, you will arrive at Route 1. The Pokemon Den gets you a free Rare Candy, which is nice. The only new Pokemon here is Abra.

### **Abra (16) Kadabra**

You can get trade evolutions in this game. For example, to evolve Kadabra into Alakazam, you need the Psychic Update. However only Kadabra can hold this, so no Alakazam until we can find Kadabra in the wild. In Hadworf City, you will meet up with Aster, and after that, you can head to Stardust Beach.

Sandygast takes the cake for being the highest-level evolution in this section. Have fun! Once you get to the beach part, you will see Aster cornering an X Elekid. Save before you fight it, as you will need it to hold the Xenolith. This allows certain X Pokemon to evolve.

### **Elekid X (30) Electabuzz X (Xenolith) Electaburst**

Finally, you can actually find Pokemon in the gym. Here you can catch two more Pokemon.

### **Oddish (21) Gloom (Sun Stone) Bellossom**

### **Phantump (Elder Update) Trevenant**

Phantump will randomly hold the Elder Update. You don't need to catch multiple Phantump though. In this game, defeating the Pokemon still nets you the item. For Oddish, you need to get a Sun Stone through Pickup. The problem is that it could either be Level 11 or Level 31 for Pickup depending on whether this game uses the B2/W2 Pickup chart

or the USUM one. If someone attempts this, please let me know how you got the Sun Stone. The gym is the best place to grind, as the levels are the highest and Oddish + Phantump give out decent experience. The levels only range from 4-6 though so you will be here for a while. The early levels of Sandygast will be hard to train, since it is weak to both Pokemon and it is pretty slow. Good luck with the Rare Candies!

## **Section 2(Ginger):**

### **83 Pokemon/4 X Pokemon**

After grabbing your first badge, you are tasked with going to Proxim Island. You will also get the PokeWES, so you can actually see the Pokedex. Proxim Island has absolutely nothing except another Rare Candy. After returning, you can board the S.S. Meteor. Battle the Merchant for yet another Rare Candy, and proceed as normal. Once you are on Darkhole Island, you can go on another catching spree.

Make sure you have everything before you leave, as you won't be able to come back. There is a hidden Water Stone near the Lapras, and supposedly another Rare Candy, but I don't know where it is since I can't read Italian. Like with Abra, Gastly does not hold the Update, but Haunter does. Pupillon and Nunvil have a chance to hold the Dread Pendant. Once you have everything, talk to the Lapras and it will take you to the Old S.S. Meteor.

### **Grimer (38) Muk**

Once you enter the final room, you will have a fight with a Sharpedo X. Save before entering the room in case you fail. X Pokemon can't be bred either, so Carvanha X will have to wait.

### **Sharpedo X**

Once it is captured, you will be teleported to another city. Agree to help a kid get his Pokemon back, and head into the Zero Cave.

Yikes, that's a lot of high-level evolutions. Onix will randomly have the Update so keep defeating them. You can get the Razor Claw from the Pokemon Den in the area. Get back Wolfey's Pokemon, and you will be able to continue to Route 3.

Hikiloo is the only grass encounter, while Geodude and Roggenrola are both Rock Smash encounters. Hikiloo will randomly hold an Ice Stone. Catch two, as you will need one for a trade. Route 4 has a few more encounters.

In the city, there are a few things to do. First, you might as well defeat all the Team Dimension Grunts. After that, there are two Rare Candies here, one of them from the Merchant. You can trade your extra Hikiloo for a Chigami. A person will also give you an egg for an Eevee. Breed it until you have 10 total.

## **(Water Stone) Vaporeon**

That is all the catches for this section! The best place to train is Route 4, as the rare Koinkoin is the equivalent to Audino as far as I can tell. It's a good thing this game gives you so many Rare Candies.

### **Section 3 (Vanilla):**

#### **133 Pokemon/7 X Pokemon**

Once you are on Route 5, you can catch a few new Pokemon.

**Beefle (18) Punchbug (38) Hercurcules**

Here, we can catch our first non-story related X Pokemon. Spiritomb is pretty rare, so get some grinding in while searching. If you break a certain spot of the fence, you can find a Retro Pichu in the area. Like X Pokemon, Retro Pokemon have a separate Pokedex. However, besides a few examples such as this Pichu, the rest are the same chance to find as shinies. So I am making a decision to make these optional. After Route 5, you will make it to Stellato Town. There are no Pokemon here, since you *still* don't have the Old Rod. Battle Trey and head into the forest.

Cottonee can hold Sun Stones, and the rare Gloom can hold a Leaf Stone, so you can finally get Vileplume. The equally rare Hystearic can also hold Leaf Stones. You need three in total to get Vileplume, Wystearia, and Leafeon. There is another encounter with an X Pokemon, this time being Galvantula.

### **Joltik X** **Galvantula X**

Joltik can only be found here before Galvantula is defeated. Otherwise you need to wait until you have Cut. Route 6 has a ton of Pokemon here, but not all of them are new. There is also another Rare Candy on this Route for you to take.

As I am sure you know by now, the Pokemon that needs a stone to evolve, will sometimes hold it. We can't get Budew until Ishtar City. In Milkiway City, there is actually tall grass. This gets us our final few encounters. There is also another Rare Candy here.

That is it, and now its time for training. There is a move tutor that can teach your Eevee Fairy Pledge, so it can evolve. I would recommend Route 5, near the distorted tree for training. You can find both Audino and Koinkoin there, and they have higher rates then anywhere else on the Route. Shawkbird and the occasional Spiritomb aren't bad either.

### **Section 4 (Nuphar):**

## **202 Pokemon/7 X Pokemon**

After beating the gym, you are allowed to go to Gravity Tunnel. The Pokemon differ whether you are on the outside or the inside.

**Pepequeno (Fire Stone) Scovile**

**Plusle**

**Minun**

**Whismur (20) Loudred (40) Exploud**

**Stunky (34) Skuntank**

**Smeargle**

**Flareon**

On the inside you can find a bunch of cave dwelling Pokemon and Team Dimension. Beating them will let you take a fossil. It doesn't matter which one you choose since you get them both in the same section.

**Diglett (26) Dugtrio**

**Aron (32) Lairon (42) Aggron**

There are two more Rare Candies here, one of which is from the Merchant. Once you beat the Team Dimension Grunts, a nearby Fisherman will give you the Old Rod when you speak to him. We get Fly in this section, so I'll cover the ones we have to backtrack to later. For now we can fish in the cave. Kidoon can be found on the outside.

When you emerge on Route 7, you can start catching right away!

Here is where you can find wild Kadabra. This allows you to get the Update for Alakazam. When you arrive in Ishtar, defeat the Gengar immediately so you can open up the rest of the city. Another Merchant is

here, so that is another Rare Candy. You can also get a Lucky Egg and the incenses. This allows us to get Budew.

### **Budew (Breed Roselia)**

Head back through Gravity Tunnel and head north. You will arrive on Route 12, where there is a few Pokemon and one very big one.

All of them are grass encounters except Shuckle, which is a Rock Smash encounter. This game seems to not get easier, as it keeps throwing high-level evolutions in your face. Make a pit stop in Fortbelt Town and grab the Compressed Update. This allows you to get Gigalith.

### **Gigalith**

Head over to the volcano and battle the Merchant for another Rare Candy. Of course, there are also new Pokemon to catch here.

Here you can find wild Graveler. The easiest way to find them is on the mountainside at night. Now you can finally get Golem. All we need now



is a Haunter. Once you get your starter back, you will get Fly. Time to do some backtracking.

Carvanha can be found on Darkhole Island, and Remoraid can be found in Newtron. Finally, head back to Fortbelt, and talk to the move tutor so you can teach your Eevee Dragon Pledge. Cofagrigus is in the gym and this is why you need Shulong. It is shiny too so that is cool. For training, there aren't a lot of good places. Route 7 has Koinkoin, but the mountainside of the Volcano has the highest levels. I would recommend here at night, since Graveler replaces Geodude.

**Section 5 (Caspar):**  
**242 Pokemon/11 X Pokemon**

The first thing you should do is head back to Route 7. The soldier blocking the way is gone, and this allows you to get Yamask X.

**Yamask X (34) Cofagrigus X**

Next, head to the Sunflare Canyon to catch some Pokemon. Another Merchant is here, so that is another Rare Candy.

**Vroombug (Spare Parts) Skravroom**

You will have to battle another X Pokemon that you can't catch. Partway through the canyon, you will see some grass that looks like an arrow. Follow the path to get to Area Dugtrio.

Next on your list is Steelix Gorge. You will have to battle even more of Team Dimension, but afterwards you will be rewarded with an X Ponyta.

Westar City actually has tall grass, so you can get some encounters, including wild Haunter, so you can finally get Gengar.

There is also a cemetery in town, which gets you a few more encounters.

**Scaracno (30) Scaraculo (Level up in cemetery) Scarphasmo**

Your final location to catch Pokemon is the Wild Bull Saloon, which you visit as part of the story.

If you haven't had any luck getting the Update for Gengar, the Pokemon Den here has it. That is it for this section! The best place to grind is probably the Saloon just because it has the highest levels.

Head south of the city to reach the train station. Catch everything you need before getting on the train. The trainers in there will give you good experience.

After the whole event on the train, you will arrive at Route 8. Here is where you can finally get the Good Rod.

To get Goombear you have to level up Chubiburny with Birigiri in the party. There are also three Rare Candies on this Route. After this Route is Hypelion City. There is only one Pokemon to catch here. You can also evolve your final Eevee through another move tutor.

Time to go on a Good Rod fishing spree!

I really thought it would be more than that. Anyways, the best spot to grind is Route 8. Rapidash and Koinkoin give lots of experience.

The first new area you unlock is the airport. Have a quick battle with your rival and get to catching!

**Pawniard (52) Bisharp**

Route 9 has another few Pokemon to grab. Take the Feraligatr to the town.

**Sandile (29) Krokorok (40) Krookodile**

**Litleo (35) Pyroar**

In the town, you can revive your fossil. Ruta will also give you Cut, so that involves backtracking to the Wild Bull Saloon and cutting down the tree.

**Cacnea X (32) Cacturne X**

Now you can head to the Cluster Jungle, where there are more Pokemon to collect.

In the jungle, there is a location called Hero's Path. Its like a Safari Zone, and you will need to complete one of the difficulties so you can get Donanas

Inside Shyleon Temple, there are another batch of encounters as well as another X Pokemon. If you put the mold of your fossil in a certain spot on the wall, a room will open allowing you to get the other fossil.

After all that is taken care of, Route 10 opens, and you can make your way to Vega City. There are even more Pokemon to catch here.

In Vega City, there are lots of things to do, but most of them can't be done until after you get your final badge. If you talk a lady on the beach, she will give you the ability to use Surf. This unlocks a huge amount of encounters.

**(South Sea Update) Gorebyss**  
**(Deep Sea Update) Huntail**

If you dip onto Route 11, you can get another X Pokemon.

Fly back to Darkhole Island and head south to Route 16. A fisherman will give you the Super Rod. Head back to Darkhole to get Mareanie. If you go back to the room you found Sharpedo X in, you can get Carvanha X.

**Mareanie (38) Toxapex**  
**Carvanha X**

This time, head south through Route 16, and catch a Staryu on the way. Proxim Island has Corsola and Feebas.

**Staryu (Water Stone) Starmie**  
**Corsola**  
**Feebas (Tender Update) Milotic**

On Route 15, catch a normal Pyukumuku, and head to Route 17. On Route 17, you can catch Popplio.

**Pyukumuku**

While you are in Newtron, head to Route 4, and Surf to catch a Seel.  
**Seel (34) Dewgong**

Fly to Milkyway City, and go to Gravity Tunnel exterior. If you Surf on the outside, you can follow the river to a hidden cave. This allows you to get Smeargle X.

**Smeargle X (Xenolith) Chientilly X**

Inside the cave, you can fish for a Dratini.

**Dratini (30) Dragonair (55) Dragonite**

Take the Route 12 exit. If you Surf in the small cave near the end, you can follow the path to find Gastly X.

**Gastly X (25) Haunter X (Xenolith) Gengar X**

On Route 10, you can Surf to access an area that has Budew X.

### **Budew X (20) Roselia**

And finally we are done! The best place for grinding is Route 10, since you can find both Chansey and Koinkoin in the grass.

### **Section 8 (Surge):**

#### **347 Pokemon/23 X Pokemon**

In a normal play through, this section is really short. You do the gym immediately after the previous gym. The only new Pokemon in this section is the Litten line. After you beat Henna, she will appear outside the gym, and she will give you an egg. Hatch and evolve it!

### **Section 9 (Aster):**

#### **358 Pokemon/26 X Pokemon**

Enter the Eldiw Casino and head down into the sewers. Here you can catch another batch of Pokemon as well as another X Pokemon.

### **Raticate (Breed) Rattata**

### **Chimaooze**

### **Trubbish (36) Garbodor**

### **Swalot (Breed) Gulpin**

### **Swirlix X (Xenolith) Slurpuff X**

Now you have to make your way through the entire Team Dimension Hideout. The only Pokemon you have to evolve right now is Trubbish, so bring it along. I won't spoil the climax, but once you are done, you can head to Victory Road, which is right off of Route 11. There you can get the final few encounters.

### **Drampa**

### **Cyndaquil (14) Quilava (36) Typhlosion**

### **Pikachu X**

At the end of Victory Road, Alice/Kay will gift you an X Pikachu. Now go take down the Cardinals! You will need a strong team though, as some of the Champion's Pokemon get into the 70's.

### **Section 10 (Postgame):**

#### **389 Pokemon/29 X Pokemon**

There is a surprising amount of Pokemon in the Postgame and most of them are legendaries. The first event you have to do is pick a starter. This doesn't matter as you can get the other starters anyways.

**Chiripe (18) Batnana (34) Vesperfum**  
**Croakling (18) Bullverin (34) Croakraze**  
**Inflant (18) Floatusk (34) Swelephant**

If you don't pick Chiripe, you can get one from Ruta at the Shyleon Temple. The same goes for Croakling with Salem at the Wild Bull Saloon, and Clover at Nova Ranch. You can do things in any way you want, but head to the sewers. Here you can get your very own Sabolt! With Sabolt, you can return to Mt. Starburst and unlock the area for Mareanie X. You can also get Turtonator, and Trishout through a series of battles.

With the newly opened exit to Route 13, you can make your way all the way to the Aurora Den. Here you can catch Squirtle. Why is this postgame only? I don't know.

Head to the Shyleon Temple so you can get Shyleon!

### **Shyleon**

The last non-legendary Pokemon are Croagunk and Toxicroak. They can be found in the swamp in String Forest. (It's the place the researchers were blocking.)

Now it is time for some legendary hunting. Mewtwo X can be found in the Team Dimension Hideout and Luxflon can be found in Welkin Falls.

## **Mewtwo X Luxflon**

Lastly, start the Dielebi quest. Catch it, and then use it to catch all the other legends. I'll list their locations here for convenience.

With all those caught the challenge is completed! If you want a big finale, go to the Aurora Den and make your way to the top with Ho-Oh and Lugia in your party. Gold will be waiting for you, so you can have a climactic battle!

## **What is missing?**

Well, there are a lot of unobtainable Pokemon in this game such as the Legendary Beasts and Dragalisk. The Xenoverse Pokedex is missing Pokemon 30-38 since they are unobtainable to the player. The last thing that is missing is the Retrodex. So its time for the optional section!

## **The Retrodex**

You won't get the Retrodex until you have completed both the Eldiw and Xenoverse Pokedexes. This means you can't get any of them until the

Postgame. However, there is one exception. You can get Retro Pichu on Route 5.

After you have finished the Slurpuff quest in Hypelion, Chrysler will teach your Raichu R a move so it can evolve into Gorochu R. The rest of the Retro Pokemon are locked until Postgame (I think). Here are all of their locations.
