Position Summary

A digital editor is required to manage the digital presence of the journal and to update social media platforms throughout the year. The position is an entry-level role and is the first position to be open to current MA students within the *Aspectus* editorial team.

Responsibilities and Duties

The Digital Editor is responsible for:

- Maintaining and updating the *Aspectus* website and ejournal.
- Launching new issues of the journal online.
- Digital output for *Aspectus* across various social media platforms.
- Working as part of the larger editorial team to deliver publications on time and to an exceptionally high standard.

Required Qualifications and Skills

The Digital Editor must:

- Be a current MA or PhD student at the University of York's History of Art Department.
- Be able to commit to seeing the journal through the publication process.
- Have exceptional organisational skills and attention to detail.
- Have excellent IT skills and the ability to manage a website.
- Have the demonstrable ability to work as part of a team.
- Have experience of working to a tight schedule.
