Project Statement

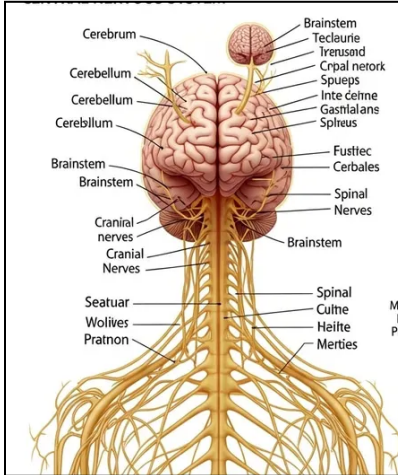
Instill objects with senience and quirks to defend the country from invasion by Japan.

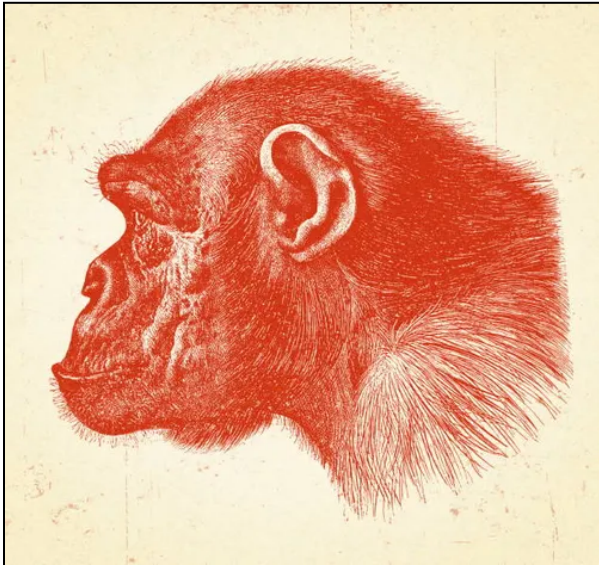
Purpose

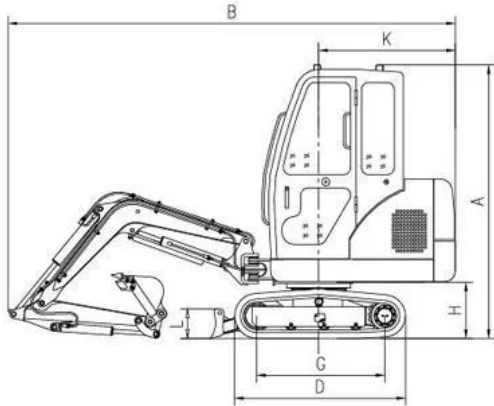
To produce an assortment of quirk-powered loyal objects and organisms to defend the nation from an attack by Japan. Using the methods and works of [DATA REDACTED] along with senience given through the Lifebreather Experiment, 500 such objects were gifted senience and developed unique quirks. Of those 500, 2% have been cleared for viewing.

Background

Japan has seen an influx of quirk-bearing heroes and villains in recent years. Even after the dismantlement of the Overhaul facility and the assault on Japan's League of Villains, formidable figures like All for One and the imitator Dark Might still pose a threat to this country. After [DATA REDACTED] had found a way to instill the root for quirk development in individuals, researchers in the QRD branch managed to find a way to replicate this process on objects made sentient using the Lifebreather Experiment. Thus was born the first experiment, number 001 - Lonebrain. With the first success achieved, the department began to take in organisms and objects that had potential and shaded pasts for experimentation.

Developed Quirk: Above Life		
Subject will not cease functioning, cognitive or physical. The subject will also reconstruct itself to execute other bodily functions like sight, hearing, and speaking. Theoretically speaking, it is the ultimate life form in this regard.		
Results of Process:		
Subject has attained levitation and speaks about the analysis of other subjects. The subject still considers itself Zandar and retains its intelligence.

	Object/Organism Background:	
	An ape by the name of Doktor was housed at a failing zoo. Has shown potential of having some higher degree of intelligence and self-awareness. The department was able to take in the primate for a small sum as compensation.	
Developed Quirk: Enigmata		
Individuals within 50 meters of Subject will suffer a decrease in intellectual capability at a rate of 1 IQ point every two minutes. At the same time, Subject will have an increase in intelligence at the same rate, as if it's stealing the intelligence of those around it.		
Results of Process:		
Lost many good researchers to the insanity of idiocy that day.		
Status: EXILED to Outer Space		

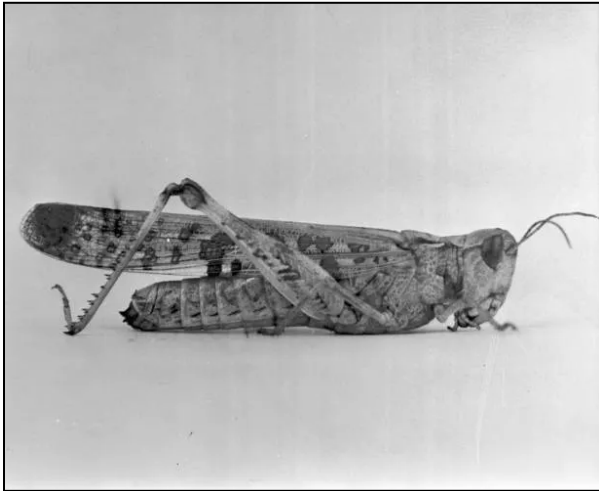
Appearance:	Designation: 036	Moniker: Dozer
	Object/Organism Background:	
	An excavator that was planned to be scrapped by [REDACTED] Constructions because they had begun to believe it was haunted by an evil spirit. The department was able to procure it free of charge.	
Developed Quirk: Integrator		
Subject can ‘integrate’ other mechanical objects into it’s body, reconstructing itself to then utilize it’s new addition.		
Results of Process:		
When integrating mechanical objects, Subject has shown to become more malicious in nature the more it integrates. Upon gaining sentience, it broke out into the parking lot. To be contained in an airtight lead cube and shall be terminated on [DATA REDACTED].		
Status: CONTAINED, SUBJECT TO BE TERMINATED		

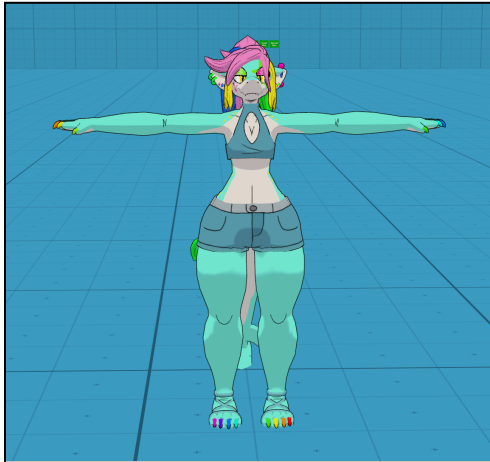
Appearance:	Designation: 049	Moniker: Eleazar
	Object/Organism Background:	
	A Bejeweled Lily Dragon (<i>Lacertae gemmatum</i>), one of the last of its species, a beautiful specimen caught in the rain forests of [DATA EXPUNGED].	
Developed Quirk: Poison Flames		
The pheromones given off by Subject are now lethal to other organic creatures. Subject has mastered control over the release of these pheromones. Subject can now breathe fire.		
Results of Process:		
The sentience and quirk activation seemed to cause an increased evolution rate in Subject. Two weeks after quirk activation, Subject evolved into a humanoid form and developed the ability to speak and follow orders. A useful subject.

	Object/Organism Background:	
	A dress mannequin holding an ornate yet pale and average-looking dress. This mannequin once belonged to a tailor named [REDACTED], who passed [DATA EXPUNGED]. As it wasn't included in the will, the department was able to lay claim to it.	
Developed Quirk: Goldweaver		
Subject can generate golden threads from its body. Subject can manipulate and control these threads at will, including the ability to sharpen the threads to a lethal degree. These threads can detect lies made by individuals in contact with the thread.		
Results of Process:		
Subject developed locomotion and levitation upon gaining sentience. A sword has developed inside of Subject that cannot be removed. Able to communicate using gestures and construct symbols using threads. Moved to [DATA EXPUNGED] for use in interrogation.

	Object/Organism Background:	
	A quaint doll of a red-haired girl. Found in an abandoned library in [DATA EXPUNGED] with no owner.	
Developed Quirk: Soul Split		
Subject subconsciously divides itself into multiple, smaller copies. This dividing keeps happening until there are 1000 subjects (a hard-limit of the quirk). Unfortunately, these divided subjects are more susceptible to being destroyed and deteriorating with age. As if the use of this quirk is like a half-life on the user.		
Results of Process:		
It followed its path, was nice and obedient to the staff's directions, and as of writing this, the last subject has passed.

Appearance:	Designation: 296	Moniker: Unicorn
	Object/Organism Background:	
	A stuffed unicorn plush made in a toy store in [DATA EXPUNGED]. This specific plush was gifted by an anonymous Make-A-Wish kid who wanted to help the people working in the government smile more.	
Developed Quirk: Prismatic		
Subject can generate rainbows from its body. While there is no theoretical limit to how many rainbows can be generated, five rainbows can be generated at once. Making contact with these rainbows brings a sense of calmness, lowered stress, and a therapeutic euphoria that wasn't addictive.		
Results of Process:		
Subject became the unofficial therapy pet of the department, and many staff members shower it in love and appreciation every day for its services.

Appearance:	Designation: 312	Moniker: Hopper
	Object/Organism Background:	
	An unassuming grasshopper.	
Developed Quirk: Henshin		
Subject can transform into a humanoid cyborg organism. Subject in this form calls itself the ‘Masked Rider Hopa’ and that it fight for the future of all humans. Masked Rider Hopa contains highly destructive power and the agility of an Olympic runner.		
Results of Process:		
Upon learning the purpose of his existence, the Masked Rider immediately rebelled against the department and took multiple armies of security to terminate it.		
Status: Forcefully TERMINATED		

Appearance:	Designation: 381	Moniker: Pooltoy
	Object/Organism Background:	
	An inflatable shark toy that was left behind at a public pool in [DATA EXPUNGED]. The neon colors found in Appearance were on the object before the experiment occurred, and the anatomic transformation was its own decision.	
Developed Quirk: Gum-Gum		
Subject's body is permanently transformed into transfigurable rubber. This rubber can be freely manipulated in any way and can stretch to no limit. When confronted with electricity and ranged blunt attacks, Subject was respectively immune and moderately resistant. But when confronted with a sharp object, Subject was severely damaged.		
Results of Process:		
Subject expressed as to having free will, and adapted a humanoid, almost anthropomorphic form. In the coming days, the Subject would escape [DATA EXPUNGED] and was lost by security.

	Object/Organism Background:	
	A discarded robot body created by [REDACTED] Electronics. QRD engineers were able to repair the body and replace the fried intellectual components. Upon activation, the body remained inactive until the Lifebreather Experiment was initialized.	
Developed Quirk: Erudition		
Subject expressed a severely increased intelligence, reaching the newly discovered 200th percentile.		
Results of Process:		
Upon startup after Lifebreather, Subject began conducting an infinite series of calculations. Researchers have been translating these calculations, which detail and predict future events and advancements in knowledge. Currently being transferred to [DATA EXPUNGED] to harness this quirk's potential for the country's future.
