Summary:

Mari and her mother work together to make signs for a march taking place, which addresses injustice. Mari doesn't think her voice will be heard, yet her mom assures her the crowd will hear. To her surprise, when Mari speaks out to shout "Love is Powerful", the crowd joins in.

Overview:

Children will explore what are basic human rights, and create a poster to display one of those rights.

Directions:

1. Read the book Love is Powerful. Discuss why it's important to stand up for your rights, such as the right to be treated equally and with respect.

2. Create a poster that displays a basic human right, see below.
