The European school uniform style with time was introduced in Asia, Australia, Chile, Caribbean Islands, Ecuador, New Zealand, Peru, South Africa and the US from the school uniform style of Italy and Spain Argentina, Bolivia ,Uruguay and several Middle Eastern countries. On 11 November 1928, in Latvia was issued an order that strictly defined how every pupil should look like – girls in dress, dark blue dress with white collar and a dark apron, but holiday wear white apron; boys dressed in a dark suit with a high collar. In nowadays there are only some schools in Latvia where students have uniforms.
