



TFAA Regional Representatives

Selection Process

- The selection process must allow for nominations from the floor and a vote from the membership.
- Selection for an incoming area representative will be handled by the area membership at a regularly scheduled meeting.
- Term length is two years, with a limit of two consecutive terms:
 - Candidates may serve future two-year terms after a two-year gap
 - If a candidate does not come forward, the TFAA Board may appoint a regional representative.
- Terms begin at TMEA 2025:
 - The DFW, Houston-area, and West Texas representatives' terms will run from TMEA 2025-2026. They can run again in 2026 for the final consecutive two-year term.
 - The Valley, CenTex and Northwest Texas representatives' terms will run from TMEA 2025-2027, with the ability to run for a final two-year consecutive term in 2027.
 - If a vacancy occurs during a term, the TFAA Board will support the region to determine an interim representative.
- January 20th is the deadline for all new representatives to be elected and communicated to the TFAA Board.

Job Description

- Lead consistent regional meetings
- Maintain an online resource folder for all area members and the TFAA Board to access
- Provide and host a virtual platform as needed for meetings
 - Meeting dates would also be communicated on the TFAA website
- Liaison between regional membership and state board
- Ensure leadership and support for all art strands
- Assist with the three conferences throughout the year (TMEA/Summer/Fall)
- Meet with the board via web-based meetings throughout the year as needed

Qualifications

- Current supervisor of Fine Arts, Director level and above when possible
- 5 years experience as an arts supervisor
- Minimum of 3 years in the region
- Minimum of 5 years membership in TFAA
- Demonstrates a high level of organizational skills
- Proven track record of high quality written and oral communication skills
- Encourages and fosters positive relationships with colleagues
