Catalyst Questions:

1.	How can I use <u>Subject</u> to explore <u>Theme</u> in my <u>Process(es)</u> using <u>Media</u> ?
2.	How can I show the relationship between <u>Theme</u> and <u>subject</u> through my <u>process (es)</u> ?
3.	How can I show juxtaposition of <u>Theme or Subject</u> and <u>Theme or Subject</u> in my <u>process(es)</u> ?
4.	How could I <u>Action</u> my art to push the exploration of <u>Theme or Concept</u> in my <u>processes</u> ?
5.	How could I use <u>Media process(es)</u> to highlight the presence of <u>Concept</u> in <u>Theme</u> ?

Themes~ Abstract or big picture ideas that can be explored.

• Examples: Technology, Science, Motion, Outer Space, Human Potential, Anatomy, History, Experience, Memory, Aging, Hardship, etc.

Process~ Methods that can be paired with diverse mediums to create art.

• Examples: Drawing, Painting, Sculpture, Collage, Printmaking, Assemblage, Storyboards, etc.

Actions~ Physical or conceptual ways to alter or personalize your art.

• Examples: Encase, Stylize, Invert, Launch, Magnify, Explode, Express, Smooth, Extract, etc.

Subject~ Tangible content that can be used to explore a given theme.

• Examples: Clouds, Organic Forms, Machines, Facial Features, Wrinkles, Furniture, Reptiles, Human Potential, etc.

Concept~ Foundations, Elements and Principles to explore in Art.

• Examples: Balance, Focus, Contrast, Form, Space, Motion, Symmetry, Texture, etc.

Media~ The specific material you use to complete a process.

• Examples: Colored Pencils, Oil Paint, Cut Paper, Found Objects, Mixed Media, Gouache, Digital Photography, Graphite, etc.
