Curriculum & Instruction Update

- Parkview teachers attended Mastery Connect training and an MC Squared Training on Dec. 3, 2021. We also welcomed the teachers from Midway and San Antonio schools at our campus, for training, as well. During this training, our cafeteria created a coffee station for all of our district's elementary teachers and a green and red enchilada lunch for them, as well (at a very nominal price).
- Our K-2 teachers continue training throughout this year on LETRS. LETRS training is a scientifically-based, structured literacy training that will help them with their English language arts instruction.
- MC squared (math) training is continuing throughout the school year, both on Teacher Training days and through MC squared trainer, Megan Kidwell, who comes to our school to coach teachers on math instruction and meet with them during their PLCs. She even works in the classrooms with our teachers and students. This program incorporates hands-on learning to help students understand math on a conceptual level.
- Our K-2nd grade classes continue testing in I-Station on a monthly basis. This testing helps our teachers determine individual students' "standards of concern" so that the teacher can best plan interventions to bring them up to (and work to exceed) grade level standards.
- Grades 3-5 have tested in the (Interim Measure of Student Success and Achievement), a new assessment required by the NMPED three times per year- The beginning, middle and end of the school year. The next testing will take place in January of 2022.

- Parkview will be having its **4th and 5th grade School Spelling Bee** on Wed., December 8, 2021. The top four students, from each of the six classrooms at those grade levels, will be competing in this event. Denise Cannon, Camelia Herrera (our school counselor) and Julie Romero (Midway principal) will be judging this event.

 6, 2021. The winning classroom will be receiving a PIZZA party.




