

Joining Rye Troop 2? GREAT!

It's time to get your uniform! These can be purchased at any scout store, or online at scoutshop.com. FYI, there's a small scout store in Greenwich, CT, and our main council store is in Fishkill, NY.

Scouts wear two types of uniform, a class “A” or “formal” and a class “B” or informal. Remember, you are going to grow, so buy large!

Class “A”

This is our dress uniform and here's what you need for it:

- Green “convertible” Scout pants (legs zip off to make shorts)
- Green webbed Scout belt
- Merit Badge Sash
- Tan Short-Sleeved Button Up Scout Shirt
- A neckerchief slide (troop gives the neckerchief)
- A few patches: 1 Greater Hudson Valley Council patch, 1 number 2 patch (our troop number), 1 purple global scouting patch (unless the shirt already has it). Instructions for patch placement can be found online. Patches can be sewn or attached using adhesive “badge magic” found at the scout store and online.
- Also get a Scout Handbook and a zip canvas cover for it. Write your name on these.
- We hike a lot, so a good pair of hiking boots is a must. Buy those wherever seems best for you.

Class “B”

This is our casual uniform. The difference is really just the shirt. Our class B shirt is currently a long-sleeved logo tech t-shirt in dark green. We include them at crossover from cub scouts, or else they are available a couple of times a year when we open a logo merchandise order. Email to ask about getting one: committeechair@ryetroop2.com
