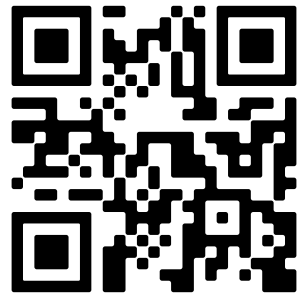
Texas Performance Standards Projects

TPSP are projects created specifically for Gifted and Talented students. They incorporate learning experiences and research to help your student grow.



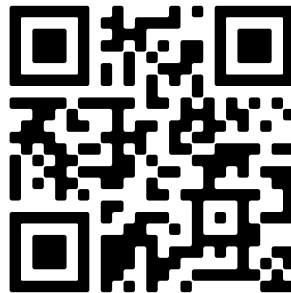

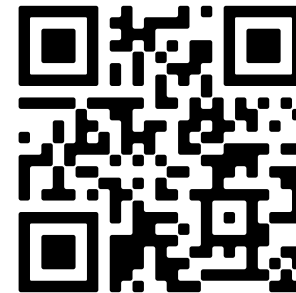
