

# Content Updates

## Language Arts

(Sloan, Johnson, Elrod, & Wright)

**Sloan/Davis/Wright:** Students will continue their ReadWorks assignment for the third nine weeks. They will analyze the short story *The Necklace* and examine how the conflict influences the characters' development and decisions.

**Johnson:** Students will argue whether a specific poem is more "love" or "love-ish" in its tone and message. By using some argumentative techniques and evidence in the poem, students will prove their claim.
