Project InSight is planning to offer an opportunity for your students to participate in Introduction to Ophthalmology as a virtual course beginning at the end of January, 2023. We are recruiting 20 High School students with an interest in the medical fields or eye health to join our weekly virtual course. This course will be taught by Credentialed Science Teachers.

In California, this curriculum has been accepted by UC Doorways as a third-year elective science course. Each individual school will need to add the course to their roster by pulling it down from UC Doorways in order to give credit to your participating students. The teachers will provide a recommended grade that you can use at your school site. Schools in other states can petition to have it approved for science credit.
