

CHSAA 4A/5A FLAG FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS

TRAILBLAZER STADIUM

100 Kipling St. Lakewood, CO 80226

Trailblazer Stadium is located on Kipling St. between 6th Ave. & Alameda. From I-25, go west on 6th Ave. to Kipling south. The stadium is located seven blocks south of Kipling and 6th Ave.

4A/5A Finals: Saturday, October 25th

4A Final: 4:00pm – #1 The Classical Academy (Home) v #2 Mountain View (Away)

5A Final: 6:45pm – #1 Mountain Vista (Home) v #3 Legend (Away)

*As a precaution, please bring both home and away uniforms. Home team(s) should plan to wear their dark uniforms and away team(s) their white uniforms.

Team Entrance: Teams will be dropped off at the north side of the stadium (*see map*). Upon arrival, the Stadium Manager will assist teams to their designated locker rooms.

Team Entry Times: First game - teams may enter no earlier than 2:15 p.m. for 3:15 warm-up. Teams should arrive no later than 60 minutes before their scheduled game time.

Buses: Team buses will drop off and may park on north or east side of stadium (*see map*).

Team Parking: Players and coaches should park in the North lot of the stadium. See map for parking lots.

Team Dressing: There are two locker rooms available on the north side of the stadium. The Home Team will be in the west locker room and the visiting team in the east locker room. Officials will also have a locker room. Water jugs may be filled up at the venue. Please bring your own water jug if you would like one at your team bench area.

**** Both teams of the first game please take your belongings with you and place behind your bench after halftime of your game, so the next games opponents can bring their belongings into the locker room.*

Warm-Up Time: A mandatory 30-minute warm-up on the game field will be allowed for each game. Warm-up location prior to official game field warm-up will be given to teams upon checking in at the stadium.

3:15pm Warm-up begin.

3:45 Teams line up for introductions.

3:48 Introduce the visiting team's players and coaches.

3:52 Introduce the home team's players and coaches.

3:56 Introduce the officials.

3:58 Play the National Anthem.

4:00pm Start 1st Championship game.

*Similar start for warm-up to second game (approximately 6:00 p.m. for 6:45 p.m.)

Team Benches: Teams will be on the opposite sides of the field. The home team will be on the west side of the field and the away team will be on the east side of the field.

Field type: Trailblazer Stadium is an artificial turf facility.

Game Balls: CHSAA will provide the match balls for each game.

Gatelist & Bench Area: Maximum on the Gatelist and in the Bench Area is 37; this includes maximum 30 players and up to 7 essential personnel - coaches/managers. A trainer may also be added in addition to the 7 essential personnel. No parents, spectators or non-school officials may be present on the track, sideline, or in the vicinity of the playing field.

Admin: Each school may list up to 5 additional names on their gatelist to help with crowd control. Please get these names to Colette to add to your gatelist.

National Anthem: If you have a student interested in singing the National Anthem, let Arin and/or Colette know.

Fan Parking, Entry & Seating: Fans should park in the east lot. Fan entrance will open 1 hour before the first game (3:00 p.m.) and is on the northeast corner of the stadium. See map for parking lots.

Fan seating for the home team will be on the west side and fan seating for the away team will be on the east side.

There is a NO re-entry policy for spectators.

Students K-12 & Seniors- \$9 (not including fees)

Passes: See 2025-26 CHSAA Accepted Passes document that will be honored (includes digital courtesy cards, CHSCA coaches cards, CHSAA media passes, CHSAA officials passes, etc.)

Concession Stands: Concessions will be sold during the games. The concession stand takes both cash and credit cards. The concession stand is located by the spectator entrance.

Officials: Game officials can park in the lot north or east of the stadium and enter through the Team/Officials entrance on north side of the stadium. CHSAA/JeffCo staff will direct them to their locker room upon arrival.

Media Check-in: Media will check-in at the northeast corner entrance with their CHSAA 2025-2026 Media pass. This pass must be visible at all times. Student media may also check-in with their school's 2025-2026 CHSAA Student Media pass and must wear at all times. Per CHSAA policy, **anyone on the field must be CHSAA media credentialed.**

Livestreaming: CHSAA guidelines are followed. No livestreaming allowed as the NFHS Network will be covering the games. Livestream link: <https://www.nfhsnetwork.com/associations/chsaa>.

Game Video: Each school is responsible for their own video. If you would like to set up your own video, it must be confirmed 48 hours in advance through CHSAA. Please reach out to Arin or Colette.

Trainer: CHSAA will provide a trainer. No training room available; there will be access to ice. If your athletes need to be taped, schools will need to provide the materials (i.e. tape). It is not the responsibility of the CHSAA trainers to provide materials for all athletes.

Tobacco Free: The use of tobacco by students, teachers, staff and visitors in or on any school property or at any student activity sponsored by the school district is prohibited.

Inclement Weather: The CHSAA Assistant Commissioner along with the facility liaison will determine if the match field is in good enough condition and playable.

- Matches suspended due to inclement weather – any suspended game will be restarted from the point of interruption and carried to its completion. The score, time and ball possession will roll over to the restarted game.
