

# Mental Health Disorder Project

## Student Objectives:

- To gather information from a valid and reliable source for one specified mental health disorder, including at least 3 resources that others could use to receive more information about the disorder
- To analyze the effects of the stigma associated with mental health disorders in relation to the specified disorder and how it may influence overall lifestyle of the individual
- To accurately define a specific mental health disorder/illness and support the definition with specific, defining characteristics including, but not limited to, signs and symptoms, treatment, causes, effects on other health components, and facts regarding incidence or prevalence

## Directions:

- This will be an independent project and you will be given time during class to complete your research; however, please plan to work on the project outside of class as well
- The project will consist of research, a creative product of your research and information (visual aide), and a presentation.
- Your target audience will be other people who want to learn more about the disorder, and friends and family of someone who may have been recently diagnosed or is currently living with the disorder
- You will present to your peers in class, and the projects may also be displayed

## Research:

## Presentation:

You will share your information and project with the class. The presentation should help advocate and promote positive relations for those who are affected by the disorder as a way to dispel the negative stigma associated with mental health disorders, and inform one another of each of the disorders in more detail. You will each complete an observation checklist of your peers, monitoring explanation of key elements.
