

Audio editing instructions

To ensure that your music is of the best quality and plays well in the auditorium, please pay attention to following tips

1. **Use high quality recording** - The better the recording, the better your final product can be.
 - Buy song from iTunes if available
 - If downloading from any other sites, try getting 320kbps quality (bit rate). If you already have a song, right click and look into properties for "Bit rate".
2. **Use a good editing software** - If you do not have a paid software, strongly suggest using free audacity which can downloaded at [cnet](http://manual.audacityteam.org/o/man/faq.html).

 - When using audacity or any software, set bit rate when saving final file. In audacity, save "export", select "options" and choose 320kbps.
3. **Test on a large music system** - Many times music sounds good on a small player but might not do well on big system. So test it.
4. **Send it in early** - If you send mp3 file early, we can test it out and give suggestions.
