

Yucaipa Stake Young Women's Camp Honor Code

The Young Women Camp Guide reminds us that "Young Women need a place where they can gather together, separate from worldly influences, feel the Spirit of the Lord, grow in unity and love, and strengthen their faith and testimonies of Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ." To fulfill the purpose of camp, we observe specific rules and standards known as the Honor Code for the Yucaipa Stake. Below are the key points:

- **Modesty:**
 - Ensure your swimsuit covers your midriff.
 - Wear shirts with sleeves that also cover your midriff.
 - Avoid jeans with rips or holes above the knee.
 - Choose leggings without mesh or cut-outs above the knee.
 - Pornography in any form is dangerous and is strictly prohibited.
- **Respectful Communication:**
 - Speak respectfully to everyone.
 - Use clean and uplifting language at all times.
- **Obeying the Word of Wisdom:**
 - This includes refraining from vaping.
- **Participation and Accountability:**
 - Stay with your cabin during required activities.
 - Always keep your cabin leader informed of your whereabouts.
- **Appropriate Relationships:**
 - Refrain from kissing, holding hands, or lying down with others, regardless of gender.
- **Cell Phone Policy:**
 - Keep cell phones in the cabins during camp activities to enjoy a technology-free experience.
- **Kindness and Respect:**
 - Be kind and Christlike to everyone.
 - Avoid pranks and any mean-spirited actions.
 - Respect others' property and follow the camp's facility rules.
- **Positive Attitude:**
 - Bring a positive attitude and a happy smile to camp.
