Identify opportunities to help spread the word.

Are there church events where you could staff a Be Smart table?

- Local or regional events
- Picnics and festivals
- Trunk or treats
- Potluck
- Coffee hour
- Other family events

What would a table look like?

- Facts and data about the dangers of guns for kids.
- Give away collateral, stickers, buttons, etc. Or have Smarties candy to attract people.

- Have a sign-up sheet to recruit more volunteers or opportunities to spread the word.
- Consider an activity for kids (such as a craft to make a bee out of construction paper).

Are there church events where you could present the Be Smart presentation?

- Family education events (not just for parents but anyone)
- Adult Formation

Identify volunteers to help spread the word.

Have you identified more volunteers to help spread the word?

- Talk with church leadership to find individuals who are passionate about this topic.
- Connect with those identified to gauge interest then give them an action (such as help with tabling, post on social media, etc.)
- Attend a Be Smart training session to explain, review resources and teach them how to present.
