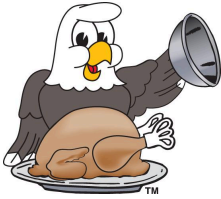

This is not an organized activity, it is rather an extra free play time for students. Same playground rules apply during after school as well.

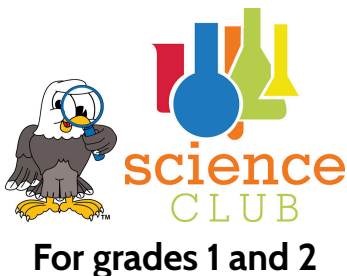
Reading Club For grades 1 through 5

Soccer Fun is focused on safety, sportsmanship and FUN, while enhancing fundamental soccer skills and confidence on the field.

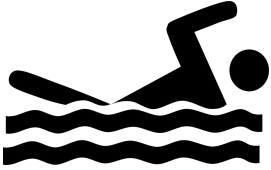
We will play creative games that increase balance and cooperation and also practice specific drills for improved dribbling, passing, trapping and scoring.

The cost for the season is \$50 per swimmer paid in the cashier's office

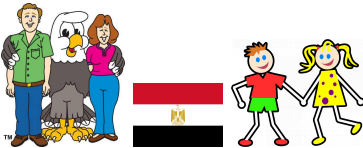
Softies is being added to the ASA list this year. "Softies" are Age Group Swimmers who like swimming so much that they wish to continue, even during the cold Cairo winter.

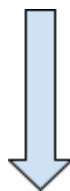

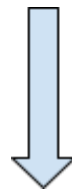
