Connecting to an RMS Wi-Fi hotspot

1. Press and hold the power button on the hotspot until it says MiFi. Once you see Sprint 3G on the hotspot screen, your Chromebook should automatically connect to the **AfftonRMS** Wi-Fi network.
2. Open up a **NEW** tab in Chrome and type in a full website address (example: www.yahoo.com).
3. Enter your login information into the content filter screen (the blue screen).
4. Click **Browse the web!**
5. Open another **NEW** tab in Chrome and type in a full website address (example: www.yahoo.com). You should now be able to browse the web.

NOTE: To turn device OFF, press and hold the power button until it says Powering Down.

Using an Affton Wi-Fi hotspot

- You are allowed 2GB of data. This is more than enough for completing assignments and browsing the web. Streaming media (videos or music) will use up this data much faster.

NOTE: Once you use up your allotment of data, the device will no longer work. You will need to bring it back in.

Hours of Operation (times the device will work)

Monday - Friday 5 AM - 7 AM and 2 PM - 1 AM

Saturday - Sunday 5 AM - 1 AM

NOTE: The device will not work during the school day.

Additional information about using an Affton Wi-Fi hotspot.

- Only two Affton Chromebooks can connect to a single Wi-Fi hotspot.
- Personal devices (smartphone, tablet, or home laptop) are unable to connect to an RMS Wi-Fi hotspot.
- Students will be responsible for any costs to repair or replace a device if it is damaged, lost or stolen (\$200 for lost or stolen device. \$15 for lost or stolen charger).
- Attempting to hack device settings, alter device configuration or reset the device will result in disciplinary actions and loss of Chromebook and hotspot access at home.
