Study hall options (no credit): Academic Enhancement A, B, and/or C (A,B,C corresponds to trimester 1,2,3 accordingly)

***Responsibility Pass:** In order to have a responsibility pass in place of a study hall, a student must be in overall good standing (minimum grades of C or higher in all classes, on track for graduation, attendance meets school expectations, no behavior referrals, etc.) and submit a request with parent permission for each trimester. Eligibility for responsibility pass will be confirmed by school administration review. Failure to maintain requirements will result in a loss of this privilege at any point in a trimester.
