3	Organization	Is each section organized like a sandwich:  Top Is an umbrella statement used to state the purpose, provide transition, and summarize the contents that follows?  Filling Is each point developed in the order suggested in the umbrella statement, i.e., does it follow the roadmap?  Bottom Does each section "wrap up" with salient points and introduce what comes next?	
4	Design	Do sectional headings identify the main parts, e.g., Introduction, Discussion, Conclusions & Recommendations, and Sources?  Are headlines informative (they capture the "news" of the section) and strategically placed?	
5	Style	Are sentences clear and succinct, not complicated? Do they use <i>more verbs</i> than nouns?	
6	Convention	Is the grammar, punctuation, and usage correct? Which areas need the most attention?
