Abstract in English should contain background, research method, results and conclusion. Should not include the reference, the table data or graphics. Abstract maximum 150-200 words.

Keywords: keywords in English; five words; separated by semicolon

Abstrak (10 pt, Times New Roman, Italic)

Abstrak dalam Bahasa Indonesia. Mengandung Latar Belakang, Metode Penelitian, Hasil Penelitian, dan Simpulan. Tidak mengandung rujukan pustaka, rujukan pada tabel ataupun grafik. Abstrak terdiri dari 150-200 kata.

Introduction (13 pt, Times New Roman, Bold)

The introduction consists

of background, the purpose of the research, and research question. As well as discuss the previous research that has ever done in other places or in other time. The research question and/or hypothesis (if any) in the introduction should not write in the form of points or should not be numbered. (11 pt, Times New Roman)

Research Methods (13 pt, Times New Roman, Bold)

Write the method in details so that other author could do the similar research with the written method in the article. (11 pt, Times New Roman)

Results and Discussion (13 pt, Times New Roman, Bold)

Sub Title (Arial, Bold, 10 pt)

Write the research results and discuss, compared with other research that ever conducted or discuss based on the theoretical framework that is used in the research. Use up-to-date references such as books that published in the last ten years and journal articles that published in the last five years (except the reference that being recommended by the reviewer in this field). (11 pt, Times New Roman)

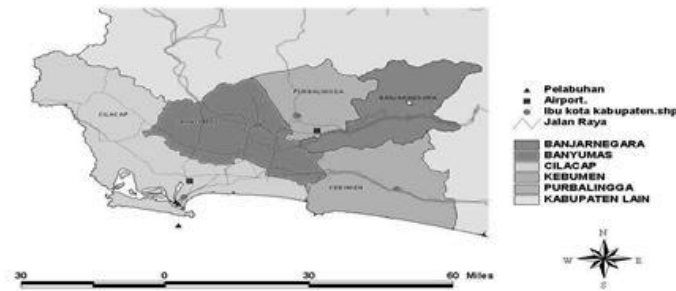


Figure 1. (10 pt, Arial, Bold)

Use capital letter in the first letter of the graphic or picture title (10 pt, Arial)

Table 1. (10 pt, Arial, Bold)

Use capital letter in the first letter of the table title (10 pt, Arial)

Conclusion (13 pt, Times New Roman, Bold)

Write the conclusion in one until two paragraphs without using the bullet points or number.

References (13 pt, Times New Roman, Bold)

The reference should be written according to the MKP journal guidelines, that uses the family name of the author at the beginning of the sequence. Example: Family Name, Abbreviated the First Name and the Middle Name. **Do not** use commas or point for the abbreviated name. For the year of the references give bracket without points.

The minimum number of references is 30 and comes from primary sources.

The reference from a journal article, anthology books or book chapter must include the page.

The reference from newspaper or magazine should include the date, month, year, and the page of the article.

If the author of the resource is unknown then write as NN.
