- 1. Curling draws are Mondays 12:00 p.m. and 2:45 p.m.
- 2. All games are 8 ends regardless of the score. Teams will get 6 points for a win, 2 points for a loss
- &1 point for each end they score. A tie is 4 points. Winning team marks score.
- 3. All games to be completed by the end of the scheduled round. If a team forfeits the game they will get 2 points for the loss and the opposing team will get 14 points for the win. Please make every effort to make up the game before the end of the round. Any uncontrollable situation will be the decision of Jake Loeppky and Denis Vassart.
- 4. Curling Canada rules to be followed for all curlers. See Curling Canada website for the up to date rules including this rule:
- (a) The use of a curling aid commonly referred to as a "delivery stick", which enables the player to deliver a stone without placing a hand on the stone handle, is considered acceptable.
- **(b)** The use of a delivery stick is not allowed in events leading to Curling Canada championships. Exception: wheelchair curling.
- **(c)** If a player starts a game with a delivery stick, then that player shall use a delivery stick throughout that game.
- **(d)** A player may not alternate delivery from the traditional hand delivery to a delivery stick or vice-versa.
- (e) If delivery begins from the hack, then players using the delivery stick must adhere to Rule 8(1) and 8(2) and, stones must be delivered along a straight line from the hack to the intended target broom.
- **(f)** The delivery may also begin anywhere along the centre line with a portion of the stone touching the centre line prior to the delivery. The stone must be delivered along a straight line from this position on the centre line to the intended target broom.
- (g) A stone delivered with a delivery stick must be released before it reaches the hog line at the delivering end.
- (h) All other delivery rules apply.

- 5. Spares play lead or second.
- 6. Curling dues: \$215.00.

5th player pays \$75.00; no charge for spares but they must register and sign the club waiver.

- 7. Suppers TBA.
- 8. The top 8 teams will play off for the Grand Aggregate and Teena's Flower trophy. The other teams will play off for the George Paul's trophy.
- 9. Curling fees are to be paid to Jake Loeppky or Denis Vassart by October 23 2023. Make cheque out to the Steinbach Curling Club.
- 10. Bell will not be used to control length of the curling game but we encourage you to keep the game time under 2 hours if possible.
