Covid-19 Protocols for 2021 EDNIN Summer Camp

Below you will find all of the Covid Protocols that we have put in place prior to 2021 Summer Camp. While the situation is continually changing, there may be updates or additions to this document. We are committed to creating a safe summer camp experience for campers and staff alike.

Pre-camp:

- Those who fall into high risk groups should strongly consider staying home this year
- 2 weeks prior to camp: No travel
 - Outside of normal area
 - Absolutely no international travel
- No one identified as a close contact
- Self-screen in the 10-14 days before

Check-in:

- Check-in time windows will be by sign-up
- Drive-Thru drop off
- Temp check
- Screening questions

General:

- Mask must be worn when not sleeping, eating, swimming, or showering
 - Each camper will need to have 10 masks (masks will be provided as needed)
 - Each camper will be given a personal drink bottle
 - Drink bottles will be filled by a designated member of staff to reduce touch points and cross contamination
- Daily temperature check and screening for Covid-19 symptoms
- Smaller numbers of kids in every cabin
- Pod groups and altered schedule to limit gathering time
- Limited whole camp gathering time
- Singing will be allowed at a moderate level with masks

Meals:

- Only people at tables are in cabins together
- As many meals as possible will be eaten outside in cabin groups.
- Staff distributes food to each person
- Staff are taking care of setup and cleaning
- Staggered Mealtimes to avoid back-ups at food line

Bathroom/Shower:

• Scheduled Morning/Evening by cabin

• Limited number in bathroom at one time

Medical:

- Mobile distribution
- Anyone with symptoms will be sent home post haste.
- Anyone identified as a close contact from before camp should notify the camp directors and will be sent home immediately

Visitors:

• No visitors will be allowed this year. No exceptions.

Camp Closing:

- No all camp closing or alternative to one large gathering
- Staggered pick-up like drop off
- Possible drive-thru

Post Camp:

- Follow-up with anyone sent home that was symptomatic
- Ask people to report if there is a need for them to be tested within two weeks after camp.
