Club Grants

Club Grants are a way for clubs to finance events that they otherwise would not have been able to do.

There will be an online form for Club Grants and this year **only advisors can apply** for club grants. To receive the form all advisors must do is email Ms.Jan.

Grants are awarded to active clubs that are already trying to finance their activities themselves. They are also meant to be meaningful and be long-lasting. This means we tentatively look to see:

- Is the club trying to raise funds themselves (clubapolooza, club kick-off, other fundraisers)?
- How many UHS students will this grant impact?
- How sustainable are the goods/services that the money is going towards (we don't want to spend a ton of money on one-time use items)?
- Clubs should be in good standing (all paperwork must be submitted properly and in a timely manner)
- Clubs must be active
- Clubs must have demonstrated longevity

If you don't have a few of these things, that's ok. All decisions on club grants will be made by a panel of ASB members and advisors, and we aren't looking for every club to tick all the boxes. We want to make sure that the money being awarded is being used to better the University High School community as a whole.

Grants for athletics, drama, and VAPA (Visual and Performing Arts) are awarded on a lump-sum basis and will not be considered for a club grant.

Travel grants (for academic clubs that must travel to their competitions) are meant to help defray competition costs. Some but not all of the clubs eligible for this grant are FBLA, MUN, Speech & Debate. These grants are awarded once every four years.
