New Business:

- Renew Hudle contract.
 - Video available to tape the games for coach/student review
 - Significant price increase by 6K annually
 - Previously it costs \$10,000 now \$16,000
 - \circ Previously boosters paid ½ and the teams who used the program split the other ½.
 - This increase would also affect the cost each team would pay for their portion.
 - They are providing new camera and equipment
 - Cameras located on football field and gym
 - Early access to new equipment. Current contract expires November 2024
 - Need to vote because of the increased price.
 - Discussed looking at other companies to compare YSN, Vidflix
 - Wrestling uses Matboss and it costs \$600/year
- Youth program being started
 - Coordinator being hired
 - Looking for PTO and Booster Club support
 - From the booster perspective we are not involved. We were told we were committed
 to supporting this initiative but we have not.
