Volunteer Check-In

- If the volunteer is on the list provided, they are clear to enter the pool.

Coaches Check-In

- There will be a chart for coaches to sign in and leave their contact information. When they go to sign in they will need to show you their "USA Swimming Membership Card".
- You will need to verify that all requirements for Coaches have been met and their Membership card is in good standing.
 - To do this, all areas should be green or orange, like the image on the back of this page.
 - If any areas are red or not met, then the coach is not cleared to come on deck. If there are any issues, please contact Hunter Hojnacki at 480 747 4039 and he will be able to meet with the coach.

Notes

- Officials do not need to check in. All officials will be wearing white polos, white shoes, and a nameplate.
- If we are not fully booked on timers, they may be a call for additional timers. If this is the case, those who are volunteering to come down to help will be cleared to come through.
- You may need to help direct people to the correct location.
 - Common questions for this role may be:
 - Where can I find the spectator restroom?
 - They can be directed to the restrooms through the double door you will be by.
 - Can I go see my swimmer on deck?
 - No, it is a closed-deck environment, but your swimmer is welcome to come to you in the stands.
