Scientific calculator recommended for grade 7 and above. Students in Algebra 2 through the end of IB, will need not just a scientific calculator, but a graphing calculator. We prefer students to have the TI-nspire CX II Calculator; (both CAS (OS 5.0 or higher) or non-CAS (OS 4.5.1 or higher) versions are acceptable on IB exams as there is now a non-CAS test mode available on the CAS calculators). A limited number of these are available through the school store for approximately \$150 (USD).

Secondary students are required to have a laptop for their school work which can be configured by the school for the school network. While this laptop can also be used at home for leisure activities it should primarily be thought of as a device for completing schoolwork.

Your choice of laptop should match your child's or family's educational needs. The educational program of our students requires them to do internet research and to use Google Apps for Education (Classroom, Drive, Docs, Sheets, etc.). In this case, simple, somewhat inexpensive laptops may meet their needs. Students who take multimedia-rich electives will require higher-end laptops that easily handle video, graphic editing or 3D modeling. A general rule of thumb is to purchase the best laptop available within your budget.

We recommend the following minimum specifications for a family owned, BYOD laptops. These minimum requirements are designed to ensure students have a device which enables them to fully participate in educational activities and be supported appropriately by teachers and technicians.

## Laptop

- Mac (High Sierra or higher), Windows 10 (English language only), Chromebook (Latest Operating System)
- Age - Three years maximum
- Memory (RAM) - Minimum 4 GB or more for new purchases (Lack of RAM can result in degradation of speed for students)
- Processor Type - Multicore
- Audio / Video - Students will need headphones or earbuds as well as a built-in or external microphone.
- Web camera
- 11 inches or above screen size
- Wireless capability
- Device must have a physical keyboard suitable for touch-typing (\*iPads and other tablet computing devices may be used at times, but do not meet all of the above requirements and are unsuitable as the only device for the student)
