TITLE OF THE ARTICLE

Abstract. The article abstract should be at least **1800 characters** long, including keywords. The abstract should reflect the main aspects of the research, be clear and logical in its presentation, and comply with the norms of scientific style. The main function of the abstract is to provide a concise yet informative overview of the study's content, with an emphasis on its scientific novelty and significance (**justification according to width, 10 pt., argins left and right – 1 cm.**).

Keywords: keyword 1; keyword 2; keyword 3; keyword 4 (5-8 terms separated by “;” without a “.” after the last keyword, **justification according to width, 10 pt., argins left and right – 1 cm.**)

INTRODUCTION

This file can be used as a template for formatting articles.

Important! For each article submitted to the electronic scientific journal «Open Educational E-Environment of a Modern University» a separate **file** filled by the authors must be uploaded «[Interactive EASE checklist for authors submitting manuscript](#)», which is set to the type «*Interactive EASE checklist*», providing a structured presentation of information about the authors' contributions and disclosure of possible conflicts of interest.

The Manuscript length (article text excluding abstract and references) – from 0.4 (16,000 characters) to 1 printed sheet (40,000 characters with spaces).

Technical parameters. Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt, line spacing – 1. All margins – 2,5 cm. Paragraph indent – 1 cm.

Statement and explanation of the relevance of the problem. This involves a concise and clear presentation of the problem under study, indicating its relevance and connection with priority scientific or practical tasks. Here, it is necessary to justify the importance of the chosen topic, outline its significance for the relevant field of knowledge, and show the possible contribution of the research to the development of higher education.

Analysis of scientific research and publications. This involves analyzing Ukrainian and foreign scientific sources on the research topic. Its content is not limited to a list of publications; it should also include the analytical characteristics of those publications to determine the state of development of the problem in the relevant field.

It is advisable to adhere to ethical citation principles and avoid practices that may indicate artificial manipulation of bibliometric indicators.

In particular, the following are unacceptable:

- *Excessive self-citation*, when references to one's own previous publications are provided without sufficient scientific necessity and are used primarily to increase individual citation indicators.
- *Unjustified citation of materials* of the electronic scientific journal «Open Educational E-Environment of a Modern University», if such references are not

justified by the content of the research and are intended to artificially influence its bibliometric indicators.

- *Practices of so-called “honorary” citation*, which involve unjustified references to the works of influential scientists or members of the journal's editorial board.

The analysis of scientific research and publications should be based solely on scientific expediency, relevance, and the substantive connection of sources to the research topic.

Important! Citations of sources used in the main text of the article are formatted according to APA style: (Last name, year of publication, page or range of pages of the source used). For example, (Bowers & Ludäscher, 2025, p. 73) or (Bowers & Ludäscher, 2025, pp. 75-85) when quoting an exact fragment of the source. Page numbers are not indicated in the following cases: references to a website; references to the entire book or article in general (Bowers & Ludäscher, 2025).

Purpose of the study. Formulation of research goals and objectives.

RESEARCH METHODS (optional section)

This section provides a detailed description of the application of scientific research methods, concepts, approaches, principles, and other underpinnings of the research, revealing the logic and sequence of their use. It describes the procedure for preparing and conducting the research and defines the experimental base, the objects of analysis, etc.

RESEARCH RESULTS

This section provides an analysis of the obtained scientific results and their reasoned justification, taking into account the objectives and tasks of the study, and determines their theoretical and practical significance.

All illustrative materials, tables, formulas, etc., are placed immediately after their first mention in the text or on the following page.

Illustrations. Illustrations are mentioned in the text by indicating their serial numbers in accordance with the sequence of their appearance in the article. All illustrations are numbered with Arabic numerals (for example: Fig. 1, Fig. 2). The caption under the illustration is placed in the center and is formatted as follows: “Fig. 1. Title of the illustration” (no period is placed after the title). After the caption, the source of the illustration must be indicated in the format «(Source: ...)» or it must be indicated that the illustration was created by the author independently. One blank line must be left before and after the illustration. The quality of the illustrative material must ensure clear and correct reproduction of all its elements.

Tables. Tables in the text are numbered sequentially with Arabic numerals. The caption “Table 1” and the table title are placed one below the other, aligned to the right, and the table itself is centered. In cases where a significant amount of information is contained in the

tables, a smaller font size may be used, provided that the clarity of the reproduced text and numerical data, and their readability, are ensured. After the table, the source must be indicated in the format “(Source: ...)” or indicate that the table was compiled by the author independently. One blank line must be left before and after the table.

Formulas. Formulas should be added using the editor, centered, numbered in parentheses, and aligned to the right.

where f_o is the symbol for the observed frequency, and f_e – is the symbol for the expected frequencies.

CONCLUSIONS AND PROSPECTS FOR FURTHER RESEARCH

This section summarizes the main results of the study and should correspond to the purpose and objectives of the study. In addition to presenting the main achievements, this section should also indicate possible directions for further scientific research.

Acknowledgment (optional section)

This section lists the institutions and organizations, as well as individuals, that contributed to the preparation of the research. This may concern scientific advisory support, organizational assistance, expert review, or funding that ensured the conduct and presentation of the results presented in the article.

If the research was carried out within the framework of a scientific project, scientific topic, or other activities, this may also be reflected in this section.

Funding (optional section)

This section identifies the organizations, institutions, individuals, grant programs, or other sources that provided funding for the research. The nature and form of support, if any, are provided to ensure transparency and openness of funding.

Authors' contributions (optional section)

If the research results are not related to large-scale experimental implementation at the Ukrainian or international level, and the number of authors exceeds four, it is necessary to clearly justify the individual contribution of each author(s). The issue of authorship must be previously agreed upon by all authors of the study before the start of manuscript preparation and finally confirmed before its submission to the journal. This section briefly describes the contribution of each author. Extended information is submitted using the Ukrainian-language [EASE Interactive Checklist for Submitting Authors \(Form 2\)](#).

Competing Interests

This section provides information on the presence or absence of a conflict of interest that may affect the objectivity of submission, review, or editorial decisions. It indicates whether there are potential professional/scientific or personal circumstances that could affect the study's results or their interpretation.

In case of a conflict of interest, extended information is provided using the Ukrainian-language [EASE Interactive Checklist for Submitting Authors \(Form 3\)](#).

Declaration on Generative AI

This section lists the artificial intelligence tools used in preparing the study. Authors should note they are fully responsible for the content and accuracy of the publication.

For example, during the preparation of the study, the authors used Grammarly Pro for technical editing of the text, in particular to check grammar and identify possible text borrowings. After applying the appropriate tools, the material was additionally reviewed and edited by the authors. The authors are fully responsible for the content and accuracy of the published material.

REFERENCES

The references should be formatted according to APA style (<https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines/references/examples>).

- The list of used sources should only include sources that are mentioned in the text of the submission.
- Sources are listed in the order in which they are mentioned in the article in a separate paragraph, without numbering.
- If the article has a DOI, it must be indicated.
- The list of sources should consist of no fewer than 10 and no more than 30 titles.
- The authors' self-citation should not exceed 15% of the total number of sources listed in the bibliography.
- In the list of sources, we recommend using at least 40% of publications indexed in Scopus/WoS, which demonstrates the author(s)' knowledge of the chosen topic at the international level.
- Russian publications or publications financed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Belarus, and Russian-language publications cannot be included in the list of used sources.
