

On September 1, 2019 Norman passed an ordinance making it illegal to tether an animal without supervision. It's still unclear at the time how Norman Animal Welfare will enforce this law and whether or not it will allow exceptions. You will have to speak with an animal welfare officer to determine what the current status is on the situation.
